Sending you the balance of the field notes returned to me for corrections., along with the F/Ns of the whole Sections asked for by the Land Office in the last submission.

In Block 211-T.& St.L.Ryco. I haven't changed the notes at all as there is sufficient data on the North-West and East of them to make them OK.as they are.

In Block 210 I made the changes in the Notes for the following reasons. In the traverse line thru Sec.10-15-16 and into Sec.21,I find should be S.28°52'W.-5140 vrs. which makes this Block have Sections 1900.8 vrs. north and south; the distances east and west of the Sections of the west two tiers were made to conform to the distances found in the original corners further North and leaving the additional excess,if any, east and west in the Block 209 to the west.

The tie shown on my map from the USGSBM-4207 to the SE.Cor. of Sec.34-Blk.209 should be to the N.E. Cor. of Sec.73-Blk.14 and the SE.Cor. of Sec.34-Blk-209 is N.41°56'W.-196 vrs. The other corners in Blk. 209 I am not satisfied with so have not considered them in the construction of Blk.210.
