Dear Mr. Rudder:

With reference to par. 3 of your letter of 18 November--the East line of Sec. 13, Blk. 238 is 1917 varas as indicated on the plat and not 1930 as typed.

Ref. par. 4--The East line of Sec. 24, Blk. 237 should have been 1900 varas to agree with Mr. Thee. I ran S. 88° 52' W. - 9500 varas from Mr. Thee's NE cor. Sec. 24, thence N. 1° 08' W. - 17 varas to set my beginning corner.

With reference to the proration of the excess in the T & St L Blks. (I never have been able to find the reason) I have on file in this office a map, scale 1" = 1000 varas prepared by Mr. J.A. Simpson from a survey made by him in Aug. & Oct. 1942 and January 1943. "MAP OF A RE-SURVEY OF Blks. 227-228-229-230-235-236-237-& 238 T & St L Ry Co and Blk. G-1, Dallas and Wichita RR Co., BREWSTER COUNTY, TEXAS." This map has the excess N-S distances prorated as indicated on my plat. Map probably used in 83d Dist Court in the case of Dick Williams et al vs. Asa Jones. (2006). May have been Ex. 90 or Ex. 97.

Stovell's Surveys made for L.C. Purnell in Blks. 231-232-233-234-& 239 and for J.W. Gilmer in Blk. 235 show varying N-S excesses, some of which agree with Mr. Simpson's findings. H.R. Gards surveys/B.W. Hutcherson in Secs. 34 & 36, Blk. 235 and Secs. 30 & 32, Blk. 236 and Secs. 4-6-8 & 16 in Blk. 237 use Simpson's N-S calls. Field notes filed in 1946 have not been changed in the Surveyors Records and it is assumed that patents have been issued.

Another Map by Mr. Simpson, Scale 2000 varas per inch, showing NW and SW corners of Blk. G-1 as ordered set by 83d Districts Court and corners set from the NW corner in a survey made by Mr. Simpson June 26-July 6, 1945 indicates excess N-S distances in T & St L Sections.

Permanent corner markers are being designed by Park Officials and will be set at each turn in the Boundary Line. My reason for submitting the plat to your office for comment or recommendation was simply that I wanted your opinion on the distribution of excess and any other points which might be in conflict with other surveys. The permanent corners will be rather expensive to set along the line.
