Field notes of connecting line between  
the N W corner of Survey No 53 A & Co  
Blk C & 6 and the N W corner of Briscoe  
County

Beginning at the 14th mile  
post of the North County line the  
same being West 217 rods and South 519  
rods from the N.W. corner of said Survey  
No 53 Blk C & 6 A & Co.

15th Thence West - at 474 rods pass a stone  
mound & 2 pits in draw at 890 rods a point  
one rod South of a stone on top of ridge  
at 1090 rods a point 406 rods South of the SE  
corner of Survey No 63. D & P. R.R. Co. 1900  
was a point 23 rods South of an earth  
mound & 2 pits

16th Thence West at 558 rods a stake  
in earth mound & 2 pits from which  
mouth of Tula Cañon bears S 44 1/2 W  
at <sup>1090</sup> 870 rods a point 394 rods N of S.W. corner

Creek at 1901 ms a point 29 ms South of earth  
mound + 2 pits

19th mile Thence West at 425 ms cross Bull  
Run at 554 ms of a stone set in earth mound +  
2 pits marked (+ C.I.) on West bank of creek  
at 1634 ms a point 7 ms South of the W corner of  
Survey No 11 A + C<sub>i</sub> Blk C<sub>6</sub>. at 1901 ms a point in Red River

South of the NW corner of same survey & 112ms  
N. of the NE corner of survey No 4 same block at 430ms  
cross branch at 551ms a rock in earth & rock  
mound marked X on east hill side at  
1901ms a point in Red River.

22nd mile Thence West at 67ms a point 824ms  
N of the N.W. corner of same survey at 977ms  
a point 832ms S47W from the N corner of survey  
No 5 same block and N47E from the East corner  
of survey No 45 & S corner of survey No 46 G.C. & S.F.R.R.  
at 1070ms a point 33½ms South of a Gyp rock  
mound on River bluff at 1400ms channel  
of River 1902ms a point in sandy valley

23rd mile

Thence West at - 757 rods a point 264 rods  
S of the East corner of survey No 43 same block - at 1238 rods  
a point - 178 rods North of the West corner of survey No 45 -  
same block. Crossing Bear Run, at 1981 rods a  
point - 35 rods South of stone & earth mound & 2 pits  
in Mesquite valley

24th mile

Thence West at - 756 rods a point 330  
rods S of the South corner of survey No 53. P.I. Co  
at 858 rods a point 36 rods South of cap stone of high  
rod peak marked X at 1420 rods cross Turkey  
Creek - at 1982 rods a point 36 rods South of  
stone marked (B XXIV 1/4)

Thence West at 200 rods a point 378 rods  
South of the W corner of survey No 47 & S corner of No 48  
John F. Toney survey at 477 rods a point 26 rods  
South of the N.E. corner of survey No 147 B S & F  
Block No 10 at 524 rods a well monument 5 ft  
high at 545 rods a mound on high ridge  
at 1982 rods a point -

block at 679 a rock mound on edge of plain  
one marked (A.C.I) from which another mound  
ms N 6° 1' E. 38½ms, thence west from said  
<sup>rock</sup> mound 1324ms a point 39ms South of stone  
set in earth mound & 2 feet marked XXVII B A.

28th mile

Thence West at 477ms a point  
47ms South of the N.E. corner of Survey No 55  
at 543ms a gas pipe set in ground from  
which a stone marked XXVII to N 85° 46' E  
543½ms at 1900ms a point

29th mile

Thence West at 477ms a point 61ms South  
of the NE. Corner of Survey No 56 same block  
at 543ms pass each mound & 2 pits at  
1900ms a point -

30th Thence West at 477ms a point  
68ms South of the NE Corner of Survey  
No 57 at 543ms pass a gas pipe set in each  
mound & 2 pits at 1851ms a mound of earth  
11 feet in diameter set for the NE corner of  
Swisher County and also the NW corner  
of Briscoe County in the S boundary line  
of Survey No 57 from which the stone  
marker  $\begin{matrix} NW \\ B \end{matrix} \begin{matrix} NE \\ S \end{matrix} A$  set in circular trench &  
earth mound 15 feet in diameter & 4 feet high  
bore N53W 28ms
