Yours received stating that
Mr Waller Surveyor of Briscoe Co. has
located sur no. 7 B. S. & F. Bl 1110 in
Armstrong Co. over 2 miles from
where I locate it. I am satisfied he
is wrong in the file of stone that he took
for the bearing of sd sur no 7 for I think
I found what he started from & could find
no good reason to use it except that it was
at one of the several heads of Happy draw
& that corner as I wrote before is not on
the ground as described in original field notes.
If you will examine Briscoe Co sketches you
will find a plat & distance of a survey made
by ^{sd} official surveyor of Briscoe & accepted
by your office about 4 years ago

We have as we stated Mr. Nat G. Waller
sketch of connection from head of Happy Creek
to N.W. Cor. Ponsora Co. and to N.W. Cor. Bl.
M 9. The sketch you speak of as having been
filed in 1896 by H. P. Jones failed to connect
with head of Happy Creek, it gives connection
only from S.W. Cor. I + G. N. R. R. Bl. 6 to N.W.
Cor. Ponsora Co.

We would be pleased to get the
connection from head of Happy Creek to N.W.
Cor. of Ponsora Co. if Mr. Waller con-

nection is not correct. We find by comparing
the distance given E + South of S.W. Cor. I + G. N. R. R. Bl 6
to N.W. Cor Ponsora Co that H. P. Jones and Nat G. Waller agree
in their measurements.
