A J. H. ... Deputy Surveyor
District as hereby certify
that the N. E. corner of the David
Cole Survey N° 81 that the Bearing
tree a "Pine Oak" as described in the
Field Notes of said N° 81 standing
on the "West" bank of a branch runs
the said corner on the "East bank" of

Same branch is still standing.

That the S W corner of No 86 & the S E cor of No 87 both called for as one and the same & on the North line of said No 81. The "Lind Oak" is still standing. The "Elm" on West bank of branch is gone but roots of an "Elm" are still visible on the "West" bank of a branch of Salt creek.

That the N W corner corner of said No 81. No cotton wood ^{two} can be found. That this line men-
tioned is a well blazed line run-
ning E. & W. At a point "40 rs"
West of where said blazed line
crosses Salt creek. Thence
South 50 rs Salt creek 850 rs. Salt
creek 1984 rs. a point from
which a P.O. X 20 is due by N 78 1/2 E
110 rs. Supposed this to be the
N E cor of J. Boyd No 77 and
across Salt creek (leaving it on
the East) 3850 rs. Thence
West 1910 rs. to a point a Black
Jack 4 is by N 2 1/2 W 3 1/4 a do 4 is
N 60 W 10 rs. both these trees
suit the beginning cor of said No 77
and N E cor of No 76. Thence
South with a blazed line 900 rs to
a point on South bank of a Ravine
a Post Oak by S 84 E 2 1/2 rs & a do N 75 E

qrs. These trees are marked as
called for in the field notes of Survey
No. 764811. 1940 rs. (having crossed a
kind of salt cut) to a point a Span-
ish Oak 21 in N 13 W 21 rs. Standing
on the bank of salt cut 8 W of No 80.

Thence East crossing
salt cut 3 times 1900 rs.

Thence South 1900 rs.

(This makes the length of the Cole
E & M line. found no marks
of any kind. Through in P.O. timber)
3805 rs to a point 2277 rs East
of the W R Dalton Survey No
That has a stone mound a P.O
15 in W 5 h 2 20 & a Live Oak 12
N. 20. 2 q. found both of these trees
standing this corner marked
"A" in sketch at the end of
"3805 rs South" searched diligently
for a corner and blaze but found
none. Through in thick P.O. timber
The courses and distances
given for above were run by
me on the ground and found to
be as given above. and found
the marks on the bearing trees
called for above to be the same
as described and called for in the
copies of field notes of the respec-
tive surveys

That the S W corner of survey
No 7 made for H. T. & W. B. R. R. by me
in 1869. was made 4470 rs East
of the point A. is attached sketch
and that said distance was run
and measured by me and the
counts and I still have the
notes ^{then made on the ground} & said survey.

That B. is intended for
the N W cor of said No. 81.

That from B. Thence South
84 rs. West 1411 rs to the S E cor
of survey No. 53.

That the sketch is made
a part of this report and that
the distances marked on said
sketch are true and correct from
actual measuring on the ground
