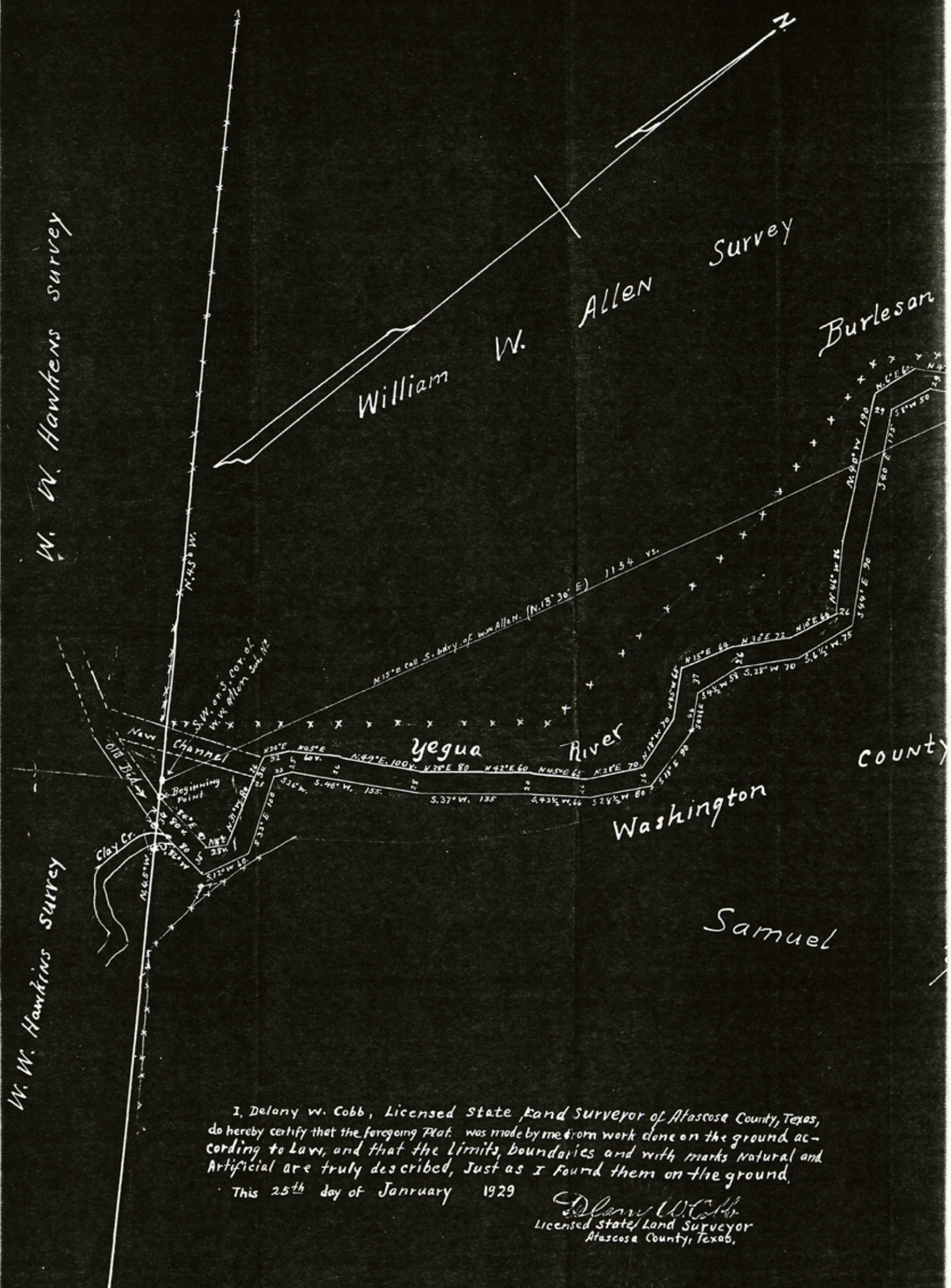

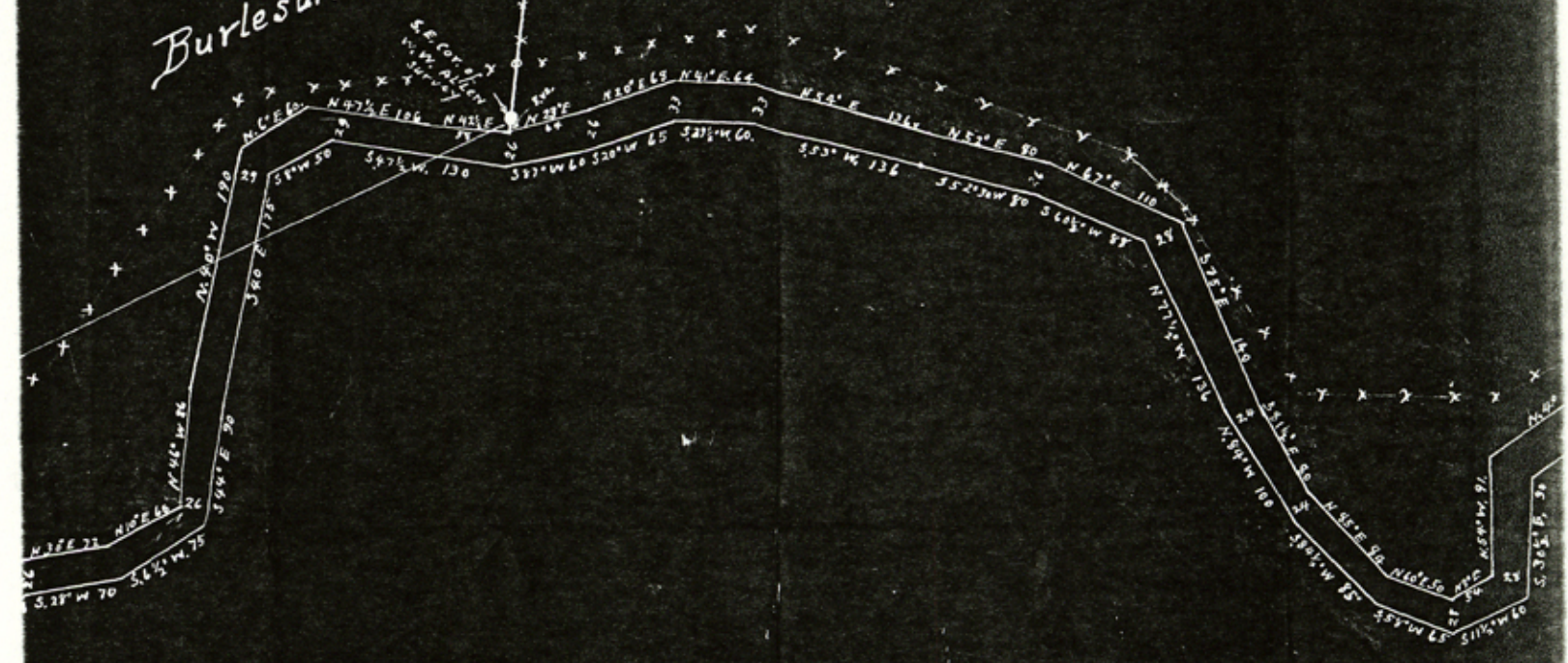

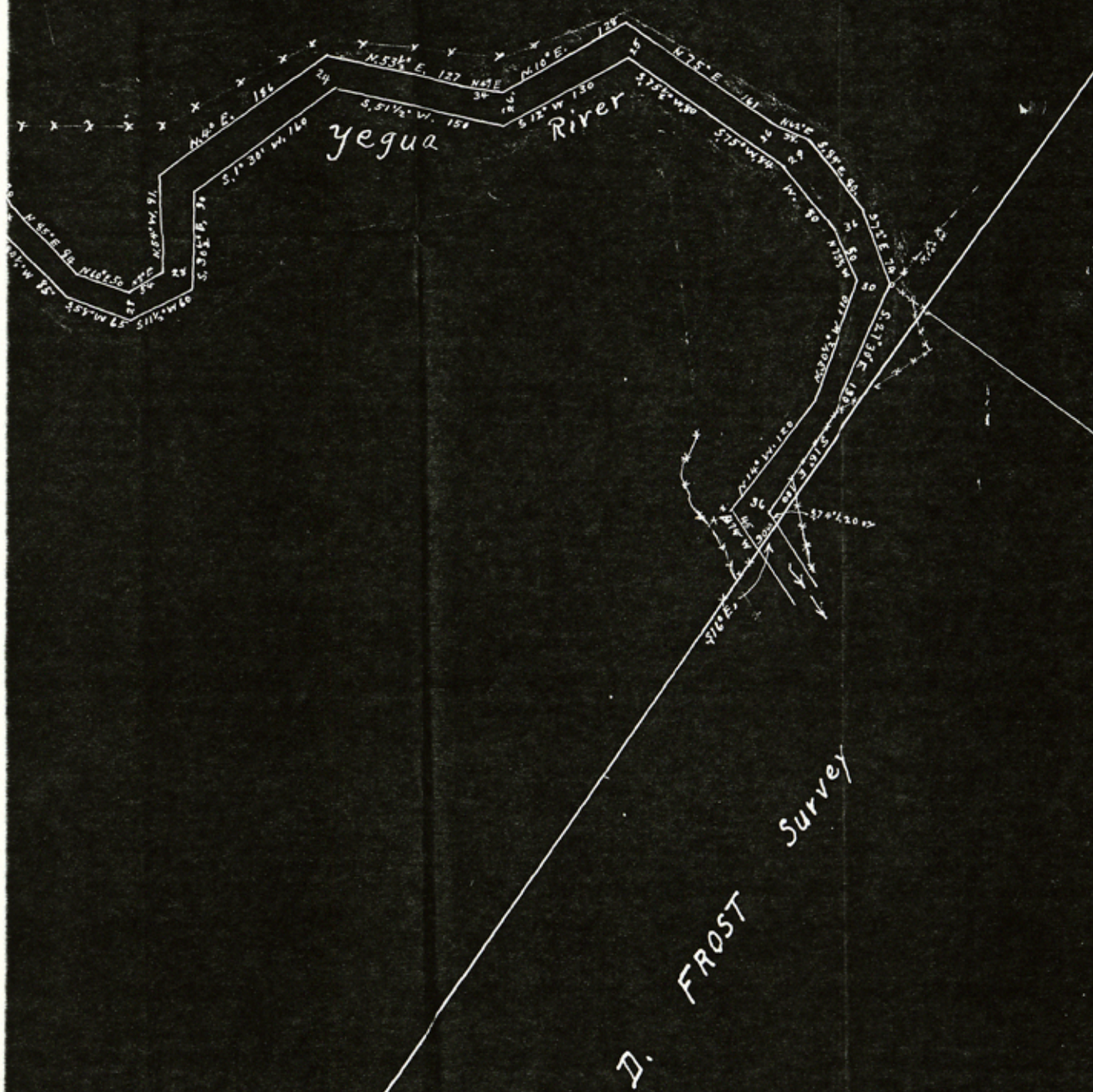
PLAT OF A PART OF THE YEGUA RIVER
