Sir by your request I send you the connection of the work on the head waters of Mosquero creek with the milium work, also the connection with the work on Hamelton creek I send you a small sketch of the work you will see from this, the connection of survey 301. to the N.W. corner of 409, S 19° E 3700 rods the connection of 300. to the N.W. corner of 301 is S 3° E 2600.0, and that of N° 308 to 305 is S 39° E 2700.0 - In running survey N° 304. I made a corner on the west side of an old survey in Milium District Thence with said old line N 19° W at 1100.0 I spaced an old corner. From the bearings is a Line to a marked H has N 78° E 16.0 & a Spanish oak marked H has S 84° E 38.0, at 1946.0 I run an another corner of Milium work to the a cedar H S 75° E 1.00 and another cedar H N 75° W 2.00 Thence S 71° W at 1165.0 another old corner stone Co. L. O. H N 76° E 41.0 & a P. O. H S 88° E 41.0. - And in running survey N° 307 at 907.0 I struck an old line thence with that line N 75° W H 36.0 to the corner of said old survey a stone over a Spanish oak H S 50° E 4.0 do. H S 66° W 12.0. This survey must be a survey of H. B. Martins
