On January 6, 1949, I made a survey of the outside boundaries of
T&NO Sections No. 7 and 8 for the D.C. Reed Estate and found excess
land in both Sections.

I begin at the old Northeast corner of the E. Story Survey as pointed out
to me and was told the old mesquite bearing was in the cultivated
garden spot and was removed. From this point I run S71W 200 Vrs to
to old fence corner and scattered Stone for the Southeast corner of
No. 7. In going N19W I found a ravine at 515 (not 115 Vrs) At 1030
Vrs I found a Ravine and at 2556 Vrs The Northwest corner of the
said GC&SF RR Survey No 33. A L Stump Brs S43E 56.2 Vrs.
From this corner I run N71E and at 170 Vrs a drain, at 479 Vrs a Branch
and at 712 Vrs a very large Lo for the Southeast corner of the
Williamson County School Land Survey. Said Tree is in the fence corner.
Satisfied that I was on the South line of the School Survey I returned
to the N.W. Corner of the G.C. & S.F. Survey No. 33 for the N.E.
corner of Sec. No. 7 and run S71W at 1514 Vrs no corner at 1736 Vrs
I found a St. Md. in perfect condition and no other rock at this location
so I believe this to be the original Northwest corner of Sec. No. 7
which is also the N.E Cor. Of Sec. No. 8.

I continued 1514 Vrs but failed to find a corner of any kind but
did find scattered stone, large stone, 200 Vrs N71E which is supposed
to be the Southwest corner of the said School Land.
I run S19E 2556 Vrs with fence line to fence corner and scattered
stone for the Southwest corner of said Sec. No. 8.
Thence N71E at ~~1514~~ 1514 Vrs no corner found only a few stones several
feet apart, at 1736 Vrs futher the place of beginning.

I also located the Northeast corner of the CH. Phelan^{100'} Survey as
well as its Northwest corner with its bearings and found the
Northeast corner of the M.M. Crant survey as described in the patent.
except that only the St. Md was found, No Bearings for the Grant Survey.

Sections No. 7 and 8 is all prairie land and very little timber.
