Bear Sir:

In reply to your letter of July 11, to O'Neal Abstract Company, in regard to the inclosed Field Notes made for A. F. Bennett in 1911, will say that there were no "Old Corners" except a single rock at the SE 25 and SW 4, and a pile of Rock at SW 25. Now the original Field Notes called for a pile of rock at the former and a single rock at the latter. Also there were no calls to locate said corners. If there had ever been any other corners set or made there were no evidence of them on the ground. I wrote the Land Office at that time and was advised to do the work in accordance with what I found on the ground.

Now in 1888, Omahondro surveyed the I&GN Land, just East of this Block of surveys and set Iron Pipe at each sec. corner, said pipe being 1930 varas to the section. In 1890 T S McClellan, State Surveyor with the assistance of Jas L Gray run out Block just south of these sections and set Iron Pipe at each sec corner at 1900 varas.

In re-surveying the sections shown on the enclosed sketch I took the Omohondro Iron Pipes on the east for the corners of the tier of sections on the east and I took the McClellan & Gray Pipes on the south for the south line of my work and ran lines north and south a mile apart parallel to the Omohondro Line and Lines east and west parallel to the McClellan & Gray Lines, making an excess of 10 acres to the section, said east & west lines starting at the Omohondro pipe set for section corner.

Trusting that the above explanation will be satisfactory to your Department, and will meet with your approval.
