## Note.

In making the survey referred to in the accompanying Field Notes, in Castro & Deaf Smith Counties, I find that the Capitol Leagues are all in excess, and that the corners on the south of Leagues 571, 572, 573, 574, & 575, are run from the Mexico line, and are not connected with the corners further north on the East side of the Capitol Lands, which seem to have been run from a line of corners further north. The S.E. corner of League 538, a mound and 4 pits on the north of Running Water Draw is 10572 vs. N and 716 vs. West of the S.W. cor. 571, and the corners all north of said S.E. 538, approximately agree with it. There is also a large excess in the N line of Blk M7. of about 424 vs which Mr Twichell resurveyed when Mr Mabry's Deputy (on my return Mr Twichell asked me if I did not find an excess in it, as he thought at the time that his chain-men were measuring too long but that his closing came out all right.) I also made a connection between the NE cor. of M7. and the West line of Blk B5. which I have found to be the best surveyed Blk in the Country, and find it to be  $0^{\circ}49'$  more variation than that of M7. so that when I ran south from the NE M7. I put in neds. and  $\frac{1}{4}$  circular trenches as shown on sketch (on same variation as B5- which is Blks M6 & those south and

South West of it, were governed by  
Blk B 5. H. & S. N. R. R. Co., and if the  
N.E. cor of Blk M 7 were to be the NW  
cor. of M. 6., then those mid. & 1/4 circ.  
trenches would the S.W. cor. of Blk M 6.  
N.E. & N.W. Blk K 13, & S.E. 03 &c. or  
would be convenient as bearings or  
starting points in the future.

My opinion is that M 6 should be  
governed by its beginning call as  
M 7 was dis-connected from it in  
its re-survey and was held by a  
mid & circular trench. The SW cor. of  
sur. 131 and a stone the N.W. corner  
of said 131, both of which I saw  
some years ago. Should M. 6 be  
governed by Blk B 5. H. & S. N. R. R. Co.  
then it would be pulled north to  
the south line of K 14 and make  
the vacancy on the south.

As I have no field notes of  
Castro County, I cannot determine  
the conflict, or find out what  
Blk. B 5 T and T 4 should be tied to,  
but submit the accompanying  
field notes of connections & sketch.
