Dear Sir:--

A committee representing some of the land owners in block M-6 and block M-8 and block M-11, has called upon me today to ascertain if possible some method for re-surveying these blocks and adjusting the boundaries. They are going upon the ground, believing that they can induce the land holders in these blocks to agree to adjust their boundaries. They hope to be able to make arrangements so that I may search out and connect to the original corners in Swisher County which have been disregarded in recent surveys, and after doing this, I will be able to furnish your office all the facts such as they are today for the purpose of deciding and agreeing upon an official re-survey as State surveyor. I understand that Mr. Crues with others has filed upon what they believe will be a vacancy between blocks M-8 and M-6. It does not appear that a vacancy can be opened here more readily than at other points, and I fear if such a vacancy is opened and awards made, that it will lead to such confusion that the parties who are now honestly attempting to re-survey blocks M-6 and M-8 will not be able to act together for a number of them would probably be in the court, after which their boundaries would be fixed by decree, which probably could not be made to harmonize with anything else, as is the custom in Swisher. This is for your information and to enable you to assist in this matter as you think proper.
