Dear Sir:

By Col C Gibbs agent request I have
gone on the ground to locate his lands in
blocks 9T and 10T in Castro County, expecting to
receive full instructions from you by the time
preliminary bases were laid. But being away
from the rail road I did not receive your
letter until nearly all the corners were placed.
After going over the facts on the ground but
one construction seemed possible which was
to extend the work from 6T as now approved
and fit the original file still remaining on
the west line of 10T. and take corner ~~and take~~
course and distance ^{east} from the S.E. corner of
180 block Mb. The NW corner of 19 block S1
is well identified upon the ground and is
well known. It bears S 0° 53' 7" W 7 miles + 1820 ⁶/₁₀
bars and N 87° 6' 53" W 578 bars from the SW corner of
