 Field notes of a survey of
 (61,910,000) Sixty One Millions
 Nine hundred and ten thousand
 Square varas of Land made
 for Thomas J. Chambers being
 the amount of land fitted to
 him by the Government of the
 State of Coahuila and Texas
 Dated 23rd day of September
 A.D. 1834. Situated in
 Chambers County on the north
 and west of Turtle Bay and Bayou intersecting the mouth of Trinity River

Beginning at the mouth of Turtle Bay at a cypress
 tree 14 inches in diameter. Thence following the meanders of Turtle
 Bay as follows to wit, S 76° W 180 vs. S 85° W 130 vs. S 89° W 160 vs. N 86° W
