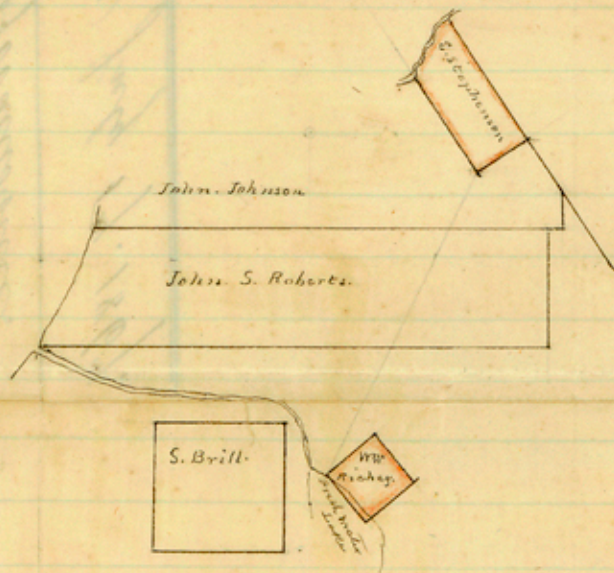


Field of a survey connecting the E. Stephenson
