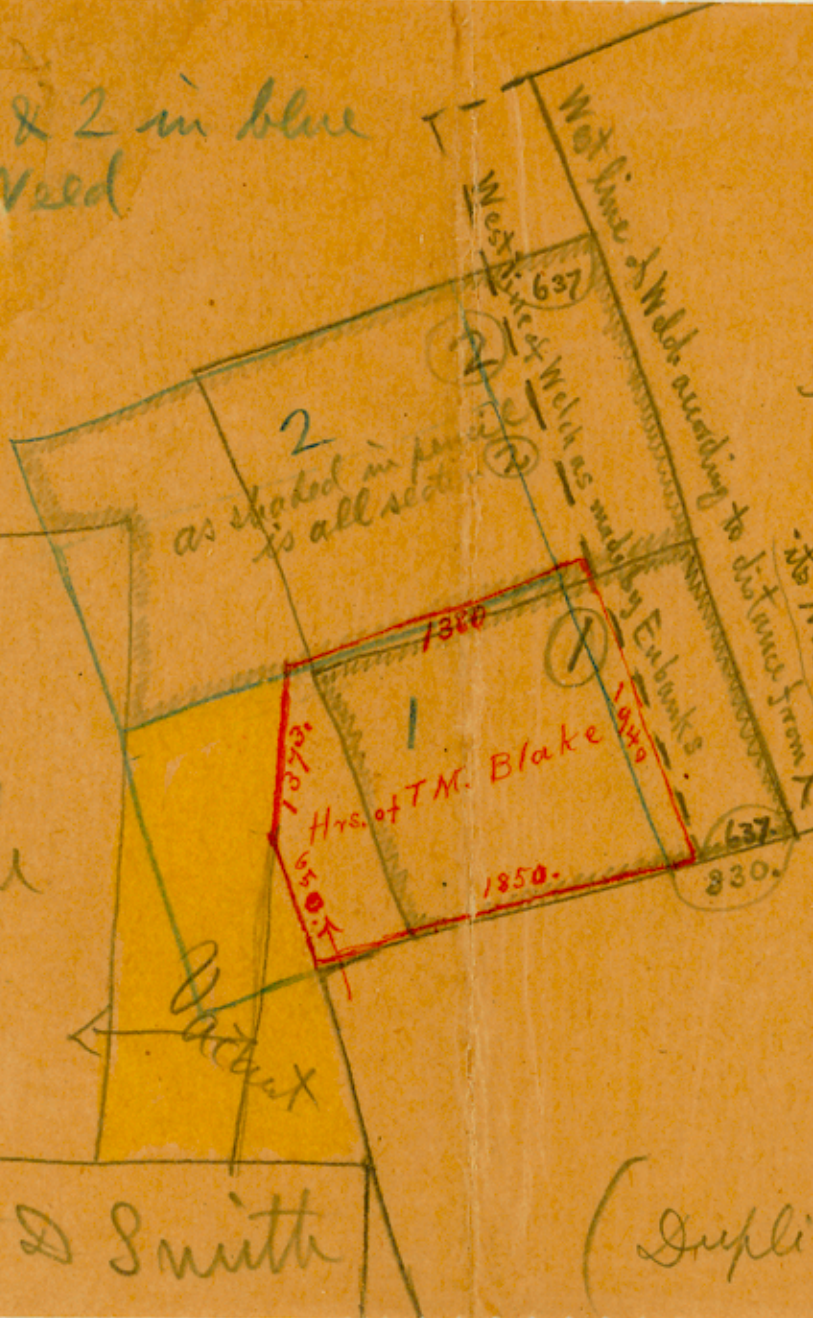

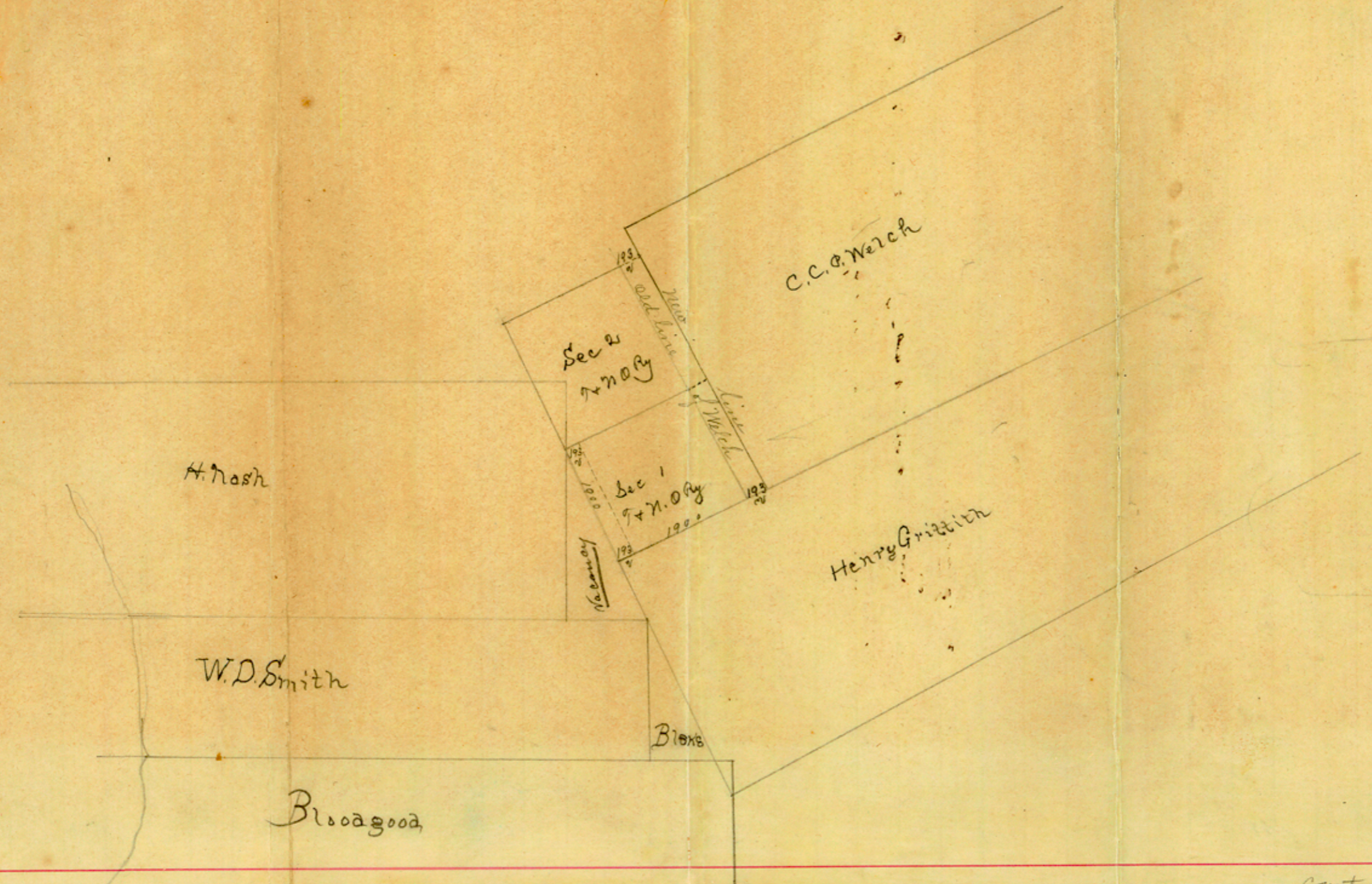

Dear Sir

I enclose a sketch of vacancy in our Co. As you know the West line of the Welch league has been pulled Eastward, by decree of Court, 1903 Noras since Sec 1 + 2 were surveyed. The vacancy thus created between Sec 2 + Welch was by instructions from your Office, included in the Hatcher Sur of school land, I have an application to survey the tract bet Sec 1 + Welch as a vacancy. Also a small vacancy on the West side of Sec 1. Sec 1 calls for Welch line as a starting point. Now what I wish to know is, does Sec 1 follow the Welch 1903 V Eastward if so the vacancy would be on the West of Sec 1, and become a part of the triangular vacancy making about 120 acres in both. Please instruct me at your earliest convenience, & oblige
