Fieldnotes of a survey of 260.94 Ac. of submerged land
being all of that part of Robinsons Lake which is not absorbed
by the adjoining surveys on the north: said survey being made
for A.J. LONG by virtue of his mineral file application No. 708
which was filed with the County Surveyor of Chambers County on
the 11 th. Day of June, A.D. 1929, at 4:10 OClock P.M. and was recorded in
Book 'K' Page 59, on the same date, Said lake is situated in Chambers C
County Texas, about 13 Miles Course about S 27 deg. East from Anahuac
the county seat, being more particularly described and bounded as
follows, towit:-

BEGINNING at the intersection of the ^{West} bank of the
mouth of Robinsons Bayou with the ^{East} shore line of Robinsons Lake
at a stake set at the mean high tide line Thence North 353.2 Varas
with the West line of T & N.O.R.R. Section No. 12 a point in the said
lake which is 3824 varas South of and ~~100.7~~ ^{666.8} varas East of the S.W.
Corner of the M.T.Boden League, THENCE with the south line of the said
Section No. 12, and in the waters of the said Lake at 1202.7 varas
pass a point for the S.W. Corner of the said Section No 12 which is
also the S.E. Corner of T & N.O.R.R. Section No 8, and at 2137.2 varas,
a point in the West Shore line of the said lake and in the South line
of the said Section No. 8 at the Mean high tide line for the N.W. Corner
of this File survey. Thence with the meanders of the West and South shore
line of the said Lake and the adjoining surveys the following Courses and
distances were calculated from the patent of the Wm. Moore Patent field
notes South ^(218.3) 248.3 varas.
