Turtle Bay Survey

Field notes showing the location and description of Point P2, said point being the southwest corner of submerged area Tract No. 32 in Galveston Bay, with relation to submerged areas, Tracts Nos. 32 to 40 inclusive in Galveston and Turtle Bays north of said point P2.

Beginning at Station A, (= Zero of the survey of Turtle Bay, described by the Field notes recorded in Book 2, page 462, Surveyors Record of Chambers County, Texas, and as filed with the Commissioner of the General Land Office, Austin, Texas, together with an accompanying map) the same being a  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch iron pipe in the ground on a bluff at the north end of the most western street in the town of Anahuac, and being the north end of Anahuac Base Line and from which Station A, State Reclamation Department Bench mark F29 at the west end of the north steps of the Chambers County Court House bears S  $9^{\circ}08\frac{1}{2}'E$  503.50 varas, and United States Government channel Beacon F "B" in Galveston Bay bears S  $25^{\circ}50'55"W$  2515.93 varas;

Thence from said Station A, S  $66^{\circ}17'12"W$  5022.94 varas to a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe in the ground being Station P of this survey at the most southern point of land southwest of the mouth of Southwest Pass of Trinity River from which the flag staff on the tower of the Court House at Anahuac, bears N  $71^{\circ}58'E$ ;

Thence from the said station P N  $55^{\circ}00'E$  768.64 varas to a 2" x 6' - 0" iron pipe with a mashed top driven in the ground, being Station P2 of this survey on the westerly side of Southwest Pass of Trinity River and from which Station P2 a four trunked willow with two trunks six (6") inches in diameter marked "Z" and two trunks three (3") inches in diameter each marked with three hacks, on the north side of a shallow slough about eight varas wide bears N  $35^{\circ}45'E$  109.1 varas and a 1-1/4" x 3'-6" iron pipe set in the ground for reference bears due north 5.40 varas; an intersecting point in the southerly boundary line of Tract No. 37 in Turtle Bay bears N  $25^{\circ}00'E$  5702.40 varas and the intersecting point in the meanders of the mean high tide line of the northern shore of Turtle Bay, known as Point T1 of this survey bears N  $25^{\circ}00'E$  9506.36 varas;

Thence from the said Point P2, N  $29^{\circ}36'30"E$  3238.42 varas to a 2-1/2 inch iron pipe in the ground, being Station R of this survey, at the most northern point of land at its centre line at the east side of the said southwest Pass at its north end junction with Trinity River;

Thence S  $62^{\circ}26'30"E$  2672.42 varas to Station A, the place of beginning.
