line made in Childress Co. Jan 9. 45 E.

Beginning at an earth mound S. E. corner
sec. 375 & S. E. corner sec. 366. Block No
W. N. W. R. R. Co.

Thence North making earth mounds at every
mile at five miles an earth mound for
N. W. corner sec. 370.

Thence West 3800 vrs to an earth mound
crowned with a buffalo head. the N. W. corner
sec. 400.

Thence North 5900 vrs south bank Red Riv.
7477 vrs North bank same. at 8177 vrs
a point.

Thence East 14 vrs to an earth mound
capped with a rock one marked "J. M." known
as the initial monuments.

Beginning again at the S. W. corner of section
366 and S. E. corner sec. 375.

Thence South placing earth mounds at
every mile. 5900 vrs. S. W. corner sec. 363

Thence South 580 vrs north has been level
at 1900 vrs. S. E. corner sec. 379. at 3200 vrs. cross
creek at 3800 vrs, a rock mound from
which a cave bears North 31 East 20 vrs,
the remains of a hickory (dead) tree N. 51 E.
20 vrs. Thence West up creek at 5700 vrs
an earth mound on bank of same.
Thence S. 45 W. 2688 vrs an earth mound

S. W. corner sec. 420.

Thence S. 7600 vrs rock mound, S. W. corner
sec. 416. Thence South 9800 vrs a rock mound
on North bank of Pease River.

Beginning at a rock mound on North bk
Pease River, 9800 vrs South of S. W. corner
sec. 416. Blk 'H' W. & N. W. R. R. Co.

Thence South $1\frac{1}{4}$ E. at 200 vrs South bank
Pease River, at 1345 vrs point 450 vrs East
of mouth of Shilyp or Catfish creek, at
14300 vrs a point.

Thence S. 88 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 20690 vrs a pile of rock,
the S. W. cor^r of sec. 36. and S. E. corner sec. 35
in name. A. Foreythe, from which a cotton
wood. 30 in dia. 40 vrs North of Owl Spring
bar, N. 18 W. 260 vrs

Thence North 5900 vrs a point.

Thence West 12690 vrs South bank of South
Pease River at 12790 vrs North bank same
at 10040 vrs a pile of rock established as
the S. W. corner sec. 756. Block 'H' W. & N. W. R. R.
and S. E. corner sec. No. 1. F. P. Knott.

Thence North 50 vrs cross Cotton wood creek
at 6800 vrs North Pease River, at 45600 vrs
a large earth mound with a gun barrel
in center from which the stump of a China
12 dia. vrs North 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ East 56 vrs, a China tree
8' dia. (dead) mtd. $\frac{7}{8}$ vrs N. 31 E. 31 vrs, the N. W. cor
of sec. 783 Blk 'H' W. & N. W. R. R. Co. and 6900 vrs
South of the South bank of the Red River

Thence West 3800 vrs an earth mound
N. W. cor. sec. 787.

Thence North 4000 vs cross Rustlers creek
S. W. E. at 1900 vs an earth mound at
foot of Sand Hills, the S. E. cor sec 790.

Thence West 1900 vs an earth mound S. W.
corner same.

Thence North 952 vs and West 252 vs
at Cedar post mtd 'B & B' on one side & 'F. W. R' on
the other, same being on West line of sec. 43
F. P. Grant: and 1010 vs South of NW cor
same. Thence North 1010 vs NW corner

sec 43, at 1420 vs cross Mountain creek
at 2600 vs South bank Red River at 3940 vs
N. bank same. at 4080 vs a Cedar post 6 ft.
high and 6' dia mtd. 'S. W. 21.' Thence East
440 vs a hackberry mtd (dead) X, supposed
to be the S. W. corner sec. 21. & S. E. corner sec 32
S. R. R. Co.

Beginning again at the N. W. corner sec. 783
Thence West 1600 vs an earth mound
S. W. cor sec 794. Thence South 1900 vs
a rock mound. 1000 vs west of Rustlers Cr.
S. W. cor sec. 797

Thence West 1900 vs
a mound of buffalo bones S. W. cor sec
794. Thence West 650 vs and South 500 vs
a pile of rock the N. E. cor sec. 169. and
N. W. cor 170. B. S. & F.

Beginning at the S. W. corner sec 794.
Thence S. 61 1/2 W. 774 vs to two white gypsum
rocks set in the ground one mtd 'T' established
by former surveyor as the N. W. corner sec
796.

Beginning again at the N.W. corner see 783
 Thence E. 1580 vrs west Bank Baylors creek
 1600 vrs east bank same 1900 vrs an
 earth-mound. at 7600 vrs an earth md.
 S.W. cor. sec 682. at 8500 vrs cross Grassy
 creek, at 11400 vrs an earth mound S.E.
 cor. sec 641. Thence North 8800 vrs N.W.
 cor. sec. 639. Thence East 5900 vrs an
 Earth mound N.W. cor. sec. 566 and 50
 vrs cross Co. Line Creek. 1940 vrs South
 of mouth of same. at 12470 vrs cross
 White neck, at 13300 cross Stage road
 to Clarendon 26000 vrs point.
 Thence South 2255 vrs to an earth mound
 established as N.W. cor. sec. 400.
