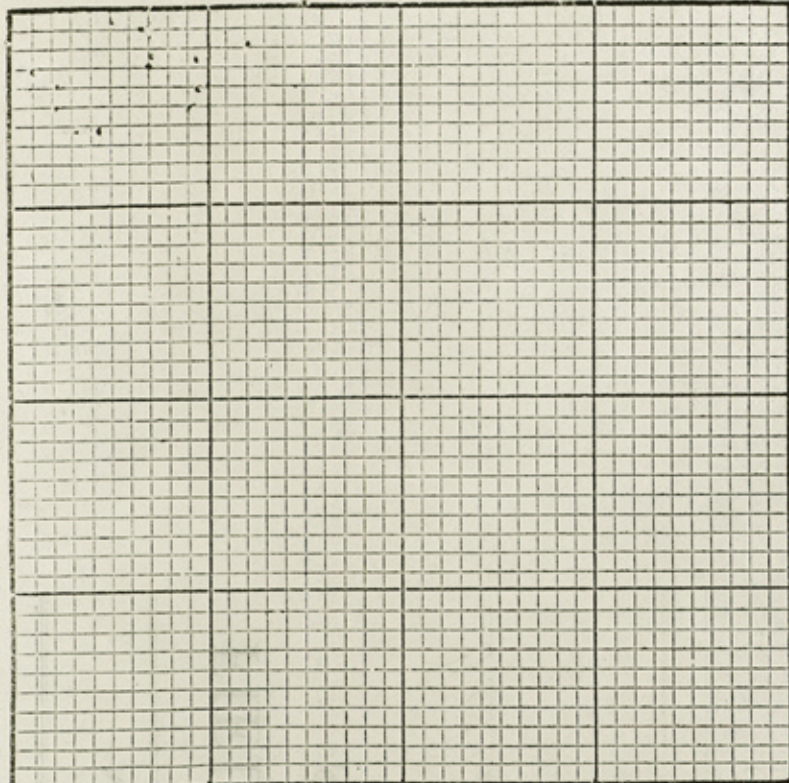

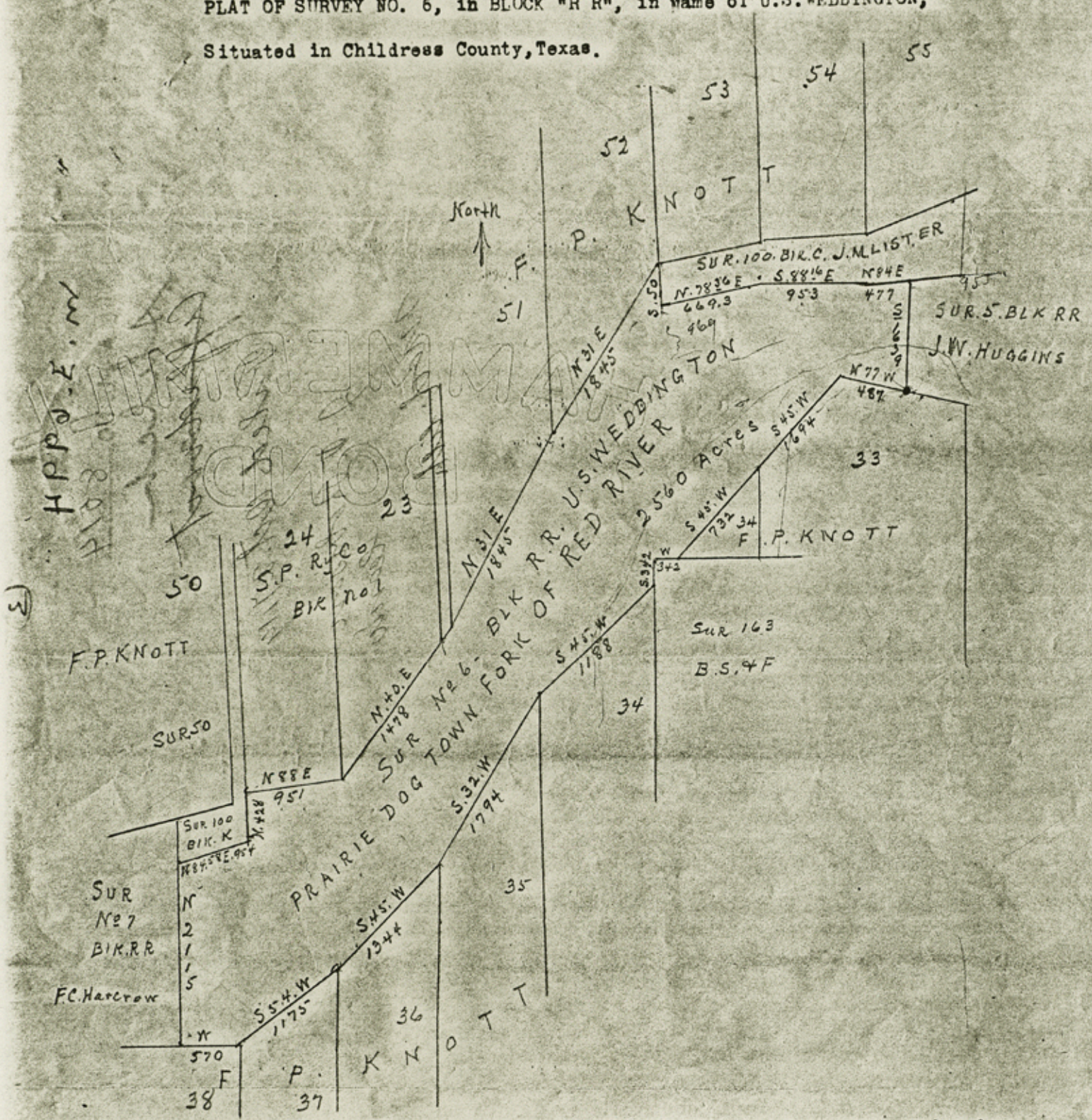

 Situated in Childress County, Texas.

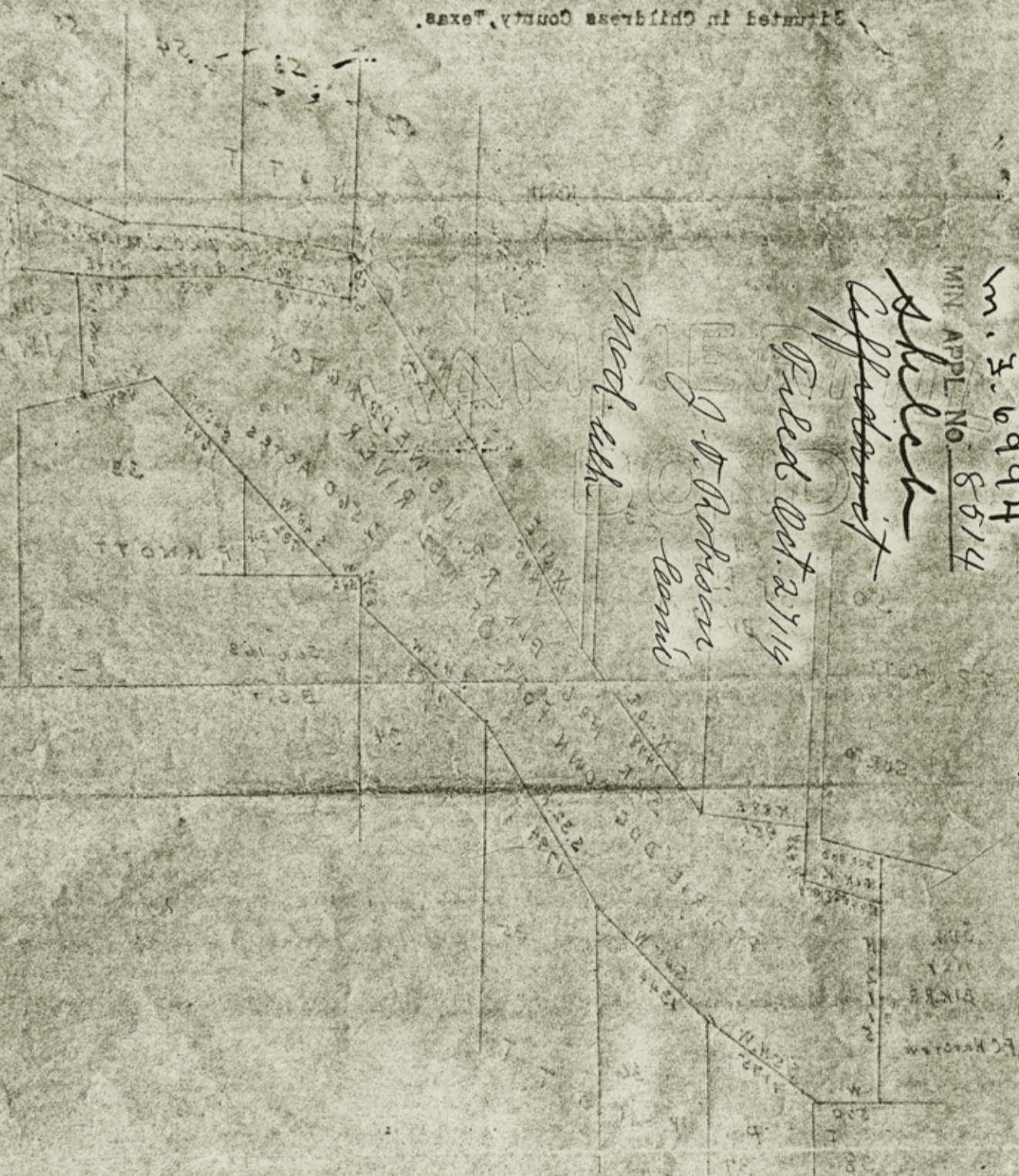
