Austin Dear Sir: The above is a sketch of surveys situated partly in Clay Co. & partly in Montague. The discrepancy represented on the Clay Co. Map does not exist on the ground as ascertained by actual survey upon the ground. The Ambrose line has an excess in nothing, but holds the excess as it begins on the N.E. cor of Orange Co. School Land & runs North ^{East} bearing plainly identified. These T. & N. O. R. R. Co. surveys have seemingly been in conflict with Orange Co. But the above sketch shows them as found on the ground by the patented surveys bounding them to certify to which.
