Dear Sir, I send you herewith another sketch of surveys on East Fork in this County, and have this to say in explanation of the same.

By reference to Field Notes of connecting line sent you dated April 15th you will see that I began at the S.E. cor of the western A Binkley sur. where I found both bearing trees plainly marked. (I also run a line west and found the bearings at its S.W. cor.) I run North and carefully measured to the N.E. corner of Sec N^o 9. T^o N.O.R.R.Co which cor is in prairie and is not defined by any natural or artificial object. Thence I run west, 2631 vs. Thence North 492 vs. to the S.E. cor of C. Chultz sur. where I found both bearings standing. I then run N with his E & B line at 900 vs. crossed Smith Creek, in all 5645 vs. a point 250 vs east of the N.E. cor of Jas Walker sur. the bearings for which N.E. cor are gone, but at the N.W. cor they are still standing from whence I run East 1500 vs. and established said cor. I will say here that all the bearings for the said Jas Walker sur are gone except the one above mentioned

and its S.B. line is tolerably accurately fixed
by the calls for branch and East Fork.

The corners of surveys down to the J. T. Crawford
are in prairie and have no fixed corners

I have found the corners of said Crawford and
connected with it as shown in Field notes, before
referred to. You will see that Sec No 8 on the
West of East Fork, has its S.E. cor on the W.B. line
of the Kellett and not on the Crawford as its Field
notes place it. This discrepancy is caused by the
survey on the East Fork being over run, and
said overrun caused Sec 18 to conflict with the
Crawford as shown on the sketch.

You will observe that the sketch shows an opening
on the South of Jas Walker. Can the Chetty, be separ-
ated from its beginning as there represented.
