 up Big Wichita, but not with its me-
 anders. S. 75° N. 840 rods; S 65° N.
 1280 rods; South bend of Deer Creek
 S. 82° N. 2100 or original creek course
 nearly West - 3100 a branch course
 N. N. 8400. South side of Lake (Campum
 and killed buffaloes) continue in same
 course in all 8600 rods - S. 65° N at
 1260 or mouth of "Deer" or Spring Creek
 1340 rods. Change course West 1340
