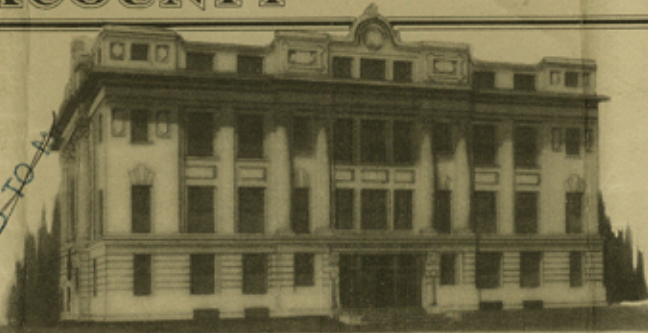

Dear Sir:- Your Files-72652-87-95 * 115944 * 123757-8.

Your letter of the 11th, regarding the above file numbers, duly received.

Sections 16 and 17 Block L and 40 and 42 Block D have been duly recorded in Yoakum County. I suppose that you know in the boundary line suit Garza County VS Lynn County No. 196-B in the 104th, Judicial District Court, Abilene, Taylor County, then appealed to the 11th, District Court of Civil Appeals, Eastland, Texas, and now before the Supreme Court on writs of error, involves all the County boundary lines from the SE corner Young County westward to the New Mexico line, and I suppose under the statutes you are not permitted to delineate the boundaries of the several counties at this time. I have followed the suit, but don't know where to say the lines are until the final decision is rendered. I have both court judgments and can furnish you copies if you so desire.

I am enclosing blue line print of the lands- the red dots are corners by me: I tied to corners by Sanders for the west line sections 127 and 158 Block D, and then set corners for some 14 sections northwesterly from his corners, using the 1930 north south and miles east and west lines, the north-south lines of Block U, Y, W and Z are read as $S0^{\circ}36'W$ and I used the same lines in Block L but read the north-south lines of 16 and 17 as $S0^{\circ}40'W$ to allow for east-west lines along the north side of Block D. C. A. Tubbs, for Sanders, I think has extended a line southerly through blocks U, Y, and W to the north line of Z, and I checked his SW 15 as OK from the original bearing corner identified as put in by Ragsdale 100 vs N of the center west corner of Section 1 Block L: W. J. Williams ran a line for the south of Harrison and Brown surveys and he fell some 135 varas east of the west line of section 1, his total distance plus the extra to the west line 1 is 21167.8 varas, he fell 22 varas north of the north line of L as set by me from bearing corner.

I am enclosing check for \$1. for filing W 440 sec. 12 Bk W.
