"for the West corner of the Carlos Flores
survey No 1003 from which a Mesq^t 10 in diam
N 24 E 14 1/2^{ft}" And the words "two Mesq^ts
of root 5 in diam bear S 77 E 4^{ft}" have

To the county surveyor of Tom

Report of connecting lines sur-
and surveys made on the ground
by G. E. Davis, Deputy surveyor of said
county, and A. S. Howren county
surveyor of Williamson county, for
the purpose of correcting the field notes
of certain surveys situated on the Colo-
rado river between the Carlos Flores
survey No 1003 and the E. line of Block
15 S. P. R. R. Co. as shown by the Map
of Tom Green county.

We began at the North corner of
the Nathan Brookshire survey No 473 in
the south line of section No 203 H. & T. Co.
R. R. Co. which corner is well defined
by a Mesquite tree which bears N 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ E
184 $\frac{22}{11}$ From this point we ran a line
due West at a variation of 9 $^{\circ}$ 45' (which
is the variation of the Brookshire and the
river survey) at 1100 $\frac{22}{11}$ passed the S. W
corner of No 203 H. & T. Co. R. R. Co., at 3000 $\frac{22}{11}$ the
S. W. corner of No 204, at 4375 $\frac{22}{11}$ the junction
of Eagle & Oak creeks, at 8140 $\frac{22}{11}$ a bend of
Antelope creek, at 8730 $\frac{22}{11}$ cross said creek.
at 8700 $\frac{22}{11}$ S. W. corner of No 207 on top of a
small mountain, at 25800 $\frac{22}{11}$ the S. W

corner of N^o 216 H & T. C. in a valley
on the east side of Yellow Wolf creek,
a stone mound whence a Magnet 10
in bears N 87 W 57th and Bart Green's
house bears S 31 E. and an old "chory" bears
S 28 1/2 W. Thence South with the West
line of 239 H & T. C. at 300th Yellow Wolf
creek, at 1700th a bend of said creek
at 1900th S. W. corner of 239 on west bank
of said creek opposite Rendleton's sheep pen.
Thence South with West line of N^o 267
at 640th west bank of creek, at 1260th west
bank of creek, at 1380th North line of Fred
Strader's fence, at 1900th S. W. cor. of N^o 267.
and N. E. cor. of N^o 300 on west side of Yellow
Wolf creek, 8th from channel. Thence South
with N. line of N^o 299, at 20th creek, at
167th intersect Nolan & Tom Green
county line about 300th East from
the 27th mile post, at 370th top creek
again, at 1380th Big Hollow branch, at
1900th S. W. cor. N^o 299 in a valley.
Thence South with N. line of 298, passing
through a gap between two tall mountains
at 1900th a stone mound for S. W. corner
of N^o 298 at the head of a hollow that
runs southeast. Thence South with N.
line of N^o 317, at 1900th a stone mound

for its S.W. cor. on a hillside that slopes
 northeast. Thence South with West line
 of N^o 470, at 1900[±] a stone md on the
 east side of a deep hollow about 18[±]
 from the channel. Thence South with
 the East line of N^o 477, at 790[±] a point
 260[±] due West from the N.W. corner of the
 Geo Gurbell survey N^o 597, at 1610[±]
 crop Yellow Wolf creek, at 1900[±] a stone
 md for the S.E. corner of N^o 477 T.C. & J.C.
 on the north bank of a branch, where
 a Musgt 4 in bears N 77 E 1[±] - In the G. Rector ^{survey}
 Thence West with the S. line of N^o 477
 at 130[±] crop Yellow Wolf creek, at 1900[±]
 a stone md for the S.W. cor. of N^o 477, about
 60[±] East of the Sweet Water road. Thence
 South with the E. line of N^o 471, at 1360[±]
 crop Yellow Wolf creek, (conies West) at
 1900[±] a stone md and Antelope horn
 in a valley for the S.E. cor of N^o 471 in
 the Young Carothers survey, from which
 a L. oak bears S 64 E - South point of Mead-
 ow Mountain brs N 59 3/4 W - Indian Grass
 Mountain brs S 31 1/2 W - Thence South
 1900[±] to a stone md for the S.E. corner
 of N^o 484 T.C. & J.C. R.R. Co. Thence West
 at 710[±] south point of a Mountain on
 north side of a gap, at 1900[±] a stone md

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for the S.W. corner of 484 on East side
of Yellow Wolf creek in a bend 90⁰⁰
south from creek, whence a bunch of
4 Elms 8 in dia. from same root, bears
N17 E 67⁰⁰ From this point we went
to the N.W. cor. of No 1001 on the S. line of the
C. Flores survey which we found as de-
scribed in the field notes of the same, and
ran thence S60 E to the N.E. corner of 1001
on the East bank of Yellow Wolf creek; thence
S30 W 140⁰⁰ to a corner of the Carlos Flores
survey No 1003 in the channel of said creek.
Thence S60 E 356⁰⁰ to a stone mark for the
S.E. cor. of said Flores. Thence N30 E at 1785
varas bluff of south bank of said creek, at
1840⁰⁰ main channel, at 2100⁰⁰ creek
again, at 2268⁰⁰ a stone mark the N.E. cor
of said survey. Thence North, at 481⁰⁰ x
Yellow Wolf creek, at 1701⁰⁰ x creek again,
at 1331⁰⁰ a point 29 varas East of the
stone mark previously made for the S.W.
corner of No 484 of T.C. R.R. Co. Thus
completing the connection between
the north corner of the Brookshire and
the N.E. corner of the Carlos Flores No
1003, the latter being 15 miles, 1071⁰⁰ West,
and 9 miles, 1331⁰⁰ South from the former.
The Yellow Wolf survey - G. Carothers

C. Reector, Geo Gunkell, Robt McRea, J. R.R. 3+4, and Jms Row - were resurveyed by C.E. Davis, and the old corners with bearing trees found, and otherwise identified, showing that sections Nos 298, 317, 470, 472, 471 and 484. 26 & 7 C. R.R. Co. conflict largely with these surveys

From the N.W. corner of 1001 we ran N30E 1543⁰⁰ thence N60W 872⁰⁰ to a stone end on the East bank of the Colorado river for the West corner of the Carlos Flores survey N2 1003, from which ~~the~~ ~~course~~ ~~is~~ ~~not~~ ~~in~~ ~~line~~ ~~with~~ ~~37764⁰⁰~~ and a Meast 10 in. brs ~~8474~~ E 14 1/2⁰⁰ - the original trees called for at this corner are gone - thence up said river with its meanders as follows:

County surveyor of Williamson County,
hereby certify that the foregoing report
made to the County surveyor of Linn
Green County, and signed by C. E. Davis
and myself, was written by me, and that
subsequently and before the filing of the
same in the General Land Office, we dis-
covered that the field notes of the Carlos Flo-
res survey No 1003 make its East line 2768⁰⁰
long, while the sketch in one possession made
it only 2700. This necessitated a change in
the following numbers to wit: 2768, 481,
1701, 1331, 79, 1071, and 1331 on page 4;
and 1543, 847 $\frac{1}{2}$ & 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ ⁰⁰, 330, 377 & 40 on page
5; and also the measure of line thirteen on
page 5, all of which was done by me, &

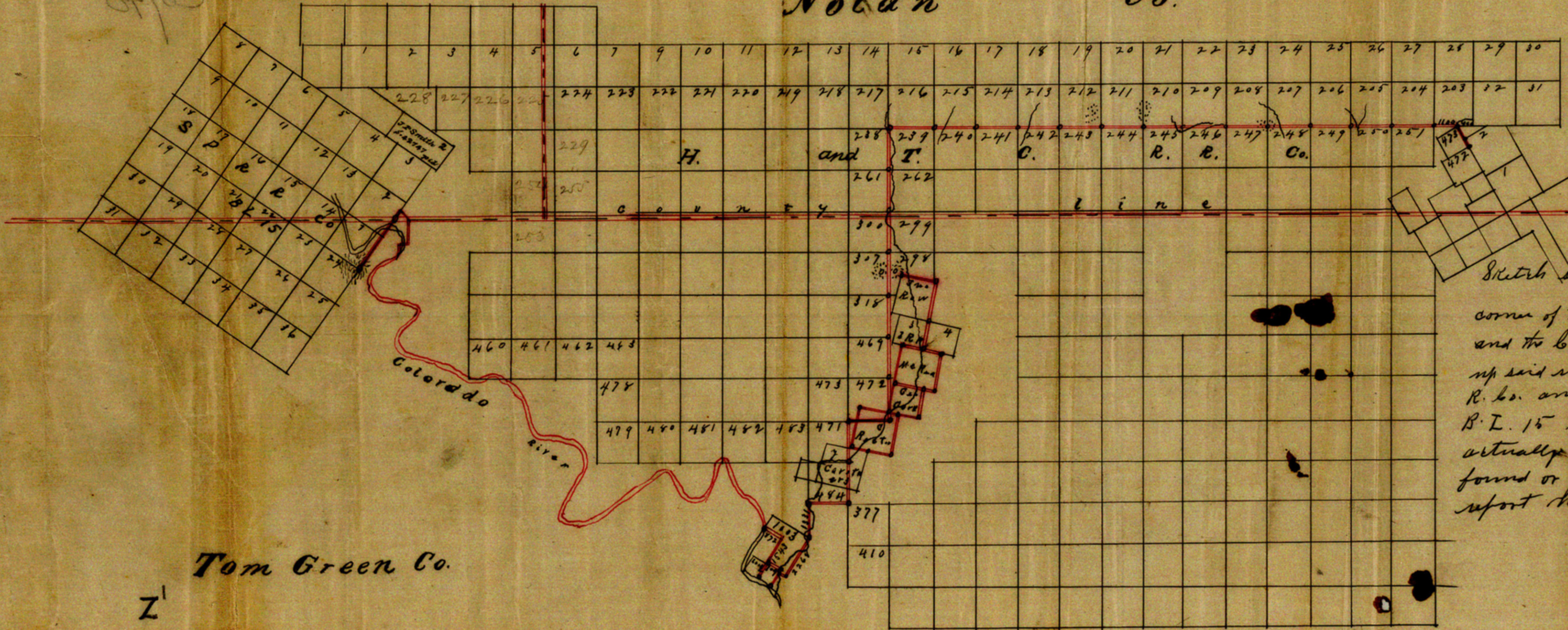
