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TO THE HONORABLE J. P. HILL, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

With leave of Court had and obtained now comes your Petitioner W. C. Blanks of Tom Green County, Texas, hereinafter styled Intervenor, and intervenes herein and for such intervention shows:

Since the institution of this suit your Intervenor has acquired from the original Plaintiff herein the title to all the lands and premises sued for herein and described in Plaintiff's Original Petition, lying east and northeasterly from a straight line joining the most southerly corner of Survey No. 36, Block 15, S. P. Railway Co. lands in Coke County, Texas, and the northeast corner of Survey No. 25, Block 2, H. & T. C. Railway Co., and the northwest corner of Survey No. 2, said block. The lands, the title to which Intervenor has acquired title, being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most southerly corner of Block No. 15, S. P. Railway Co. lands, being the most southerly corner of Survey No. 36, said block; thence <sup>in a straight line to</sup> ~~northeasterly~~ with the north east corner of survey no 25 Block no 2 and north west corner survey no 2 same block ~~the line of said Block No. 15, 1887 vrs; thence east 923 vrs;~~  
thence east with the north line of said survey no 2 to the north east corner there of;  
~~thence south 1900 vrs to the northeast corner of Survey No. 2;~~  
thence north to the most easterly south east corner of J. West Survey no 2, thence west Block 8, H. & T. C. Railway Co. lands; thence west with the north line of said Survey No. 2 to the northwest corner thereof, the line to the south corner thereof, the place of beginning.  
same being also the northeast corner of Survey No. 25, H. & T. C. Railway Co. lands; thence in a straight line to the place of beginning.

Intervenor adopts the allegations in Plaintiff's Original Petition as to residence of the parties, says that Intervenor is the owner owning the full fee simple estate therein in and to the lands and premises above described and is entitled to possession thereof.

On or about March 1, 1930, Intervenor was in possession of said lands and premises above described and was entitled to such possession. The Defendants afterwards, to-wit, on or about March 2nd, 1930, unlawfully entered upon and dispossessed Intervenor of the above described lands and premises and with-holds from him the possession thereof to his damages in the sum of Five Hundred and No/100 (\$500.00) Dollars.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, Intervenor respectfully prays that he have judgment and decree of this Court adjudging the title to the above described lands and premises to be in him, and that he recover of and from said Defendants, and each of them, the full title and possession thereof, and that he have such other relief, general and special, as he may be entitled to receive at law or in equity.

Answering Answer of Defendant Charles Eldridge, Intervenor denies all and singular the allegations of limitation therein pleaded and set up, and answering the Cross Action of said Defendant Intervenor says that he is not guilty of the injuries, wrongs and trespasses complained of against him in said Petition and Cross Action, and that his predecessor in title, original Plaintiff herein, is not guilty of

such injuries, wrongs and trespasses. *Intervenor says that said lands and premises above described are all out of and a part of Survey no 1, Block 7 H 47 C Ry Co and that where E.W. Egan Survey no 1, Block 2, wherefore Intervenor prays on his inter-  
Yield to said Survey no 1, Block 2, wherefore Intervenor prays on his inter-  
Intervenor as above set out and that the relief prayed for by said*

Defendant in his Cross Action be in all things denied and that the true boundary of said Survey no 1, H 47 C Ry Co Block 2 be defined.
