Coke County, Texas.


In the company of Mr. Henley and Mr. Copeland, I was shown the stone mound's set forth:

Northwest and Northeast corner of the Seth Clark Survey No. 475; the stone mound for the Southeast corner of the J. Holleman survey No. 305; and the old fence post at the Northeast corner of Survey No. 305; with the aid of the State Highway Right-of Way maps I located the Northeast and the Southeast corner of the J. Holleman Survey No. 308; Mr. Kirk showed me the iron pipes in the north line of the J. Holleman Survey No. 308, set by Mr. Goodfellow.

All this was tied together by triangulation and bearings and length calculated as shown, the common line between Surveys No. 305 and 306 was set by dividing the distance between the west line of Survey 306 and the east line of Survey 305, in half.

There seems to be no marks on the ground for the west side of Surveys 307 and 308, so I had no choice but to give those surveys 13<sup>4</sup><sub>4</sub> varas as called for in the original field notes.
