Travis Land District do hereby certify
that from the SW cor of Sec No
310. made for T. O'Dowd of 320 acres said
cor identified by me by its description
in filed notes ("a stone mound & 2 live
Oak bearing trees") all of which I found
on the ground North 1020 as I measu-
red to the N W cor of Sec No 312 made
for B Y Green. This cor I found &
identified by the description in its
filed notes a stone mound & 2 live Oak
bearing trees. Then I run West 1900
and looked for a cor. found none, built
a stone mound, the above was done
in June 1871.

In November 1871 I began at
said SW cor of No 310 and run
West 1900 and then North 1020
to the last stone mound mentioned
