I Lettuckite Deputy Surveyor for Travis Land District do hereby certify that from the S W cor of Sect No 310 made for F. Owen of 320 acres. Said cor identified by me by its description in field notes ("a stone mound & 2 Live Oak bearing trees") all of which I found on the ground North 1020 as I measured to the N W cor of Sect No 312 made for B Y Gilman. This cor I found & identified by the description in its field notes a stone mound & 2 Live Oak bearing trees. Then I ran West 1900 and looked for a cor. found none; built a stone mound. The above was done in June 1871.

In November 1871 I began at said S W cor of No 310 and ran West 1900 and then North 1020 to the last stone mound mentioned

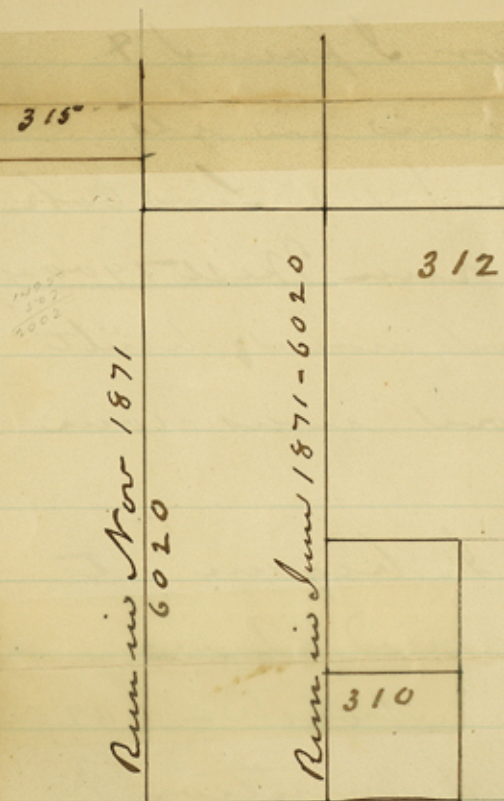
