by me and others. Also I connect Hud-
son's corners with corners and stone mound
made by R. S. Boren in location of
Coleman County School Land, Surreys
N^o 90 + 91 with L. H. Lockett's corners and
st. ma. made at time Lockett located S. T.
Belt and H. C. Weaver Surreys N^os. 286
& 287. These corners of Boren and Lockett
in connection with Hudson's corners
I consider as material. My running

down the river, show a shortage at or near the S.E. and N.E. Corner of Nos. 360 + 361 and at or near the S.E. + N.E. Cor. of Nos. 365 + 366 but while short at these two given points I find that to connect line at or near the S.E. + N.E. Corner of Nos. 359 + 360 I was compelled to extend a line South considerably over. Call in f/n. also, at or near the S.E. or N.E. Corner of Nos. 365 + 366 I find that I must go South of what Hudson's meanders Call for the distance to Corners made by L. H. Lucket shows the same difference.
