Dear Sir:

Enclosed herewith please find certificate of running, marked No 4, and get at: You will see from same that I make connections with two of J. P. Hudson's corners and recognized by me and others. Also I connect J. Hudson's corners with corners and stone mound made by R. S. Bowen in location of Coleman County School Land, Survey Nos. 90 & 91 with L. H. Luckett's corners and st. ma. made at time Luckett located S. P. Belt and K. C. Hearer Surveys Nos. 286 & 287. These corners of Bowen and Luckett in connection with Hudsons corner I consider as material. My running

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down the river, show a shortage at or near the S.E. and N.E. corner of Nos. 360 & 361 and at or near the S.E. & N.E. cor. of Nos. 365 & 366 but while short at these two given points I find that to connect lines at or near the S.E. & N.E. corner of Nos. 359 & 360 I was compelled to extend a line South considerably over. Case in f/n. also, at or near the S.E. or N.E. corner of Nos. 365 & 366 I find that I must go South of what Hudson's meanders call for the distance to corners made by L. H. Luckett show the same difference.
