certify, that I have examined the North corner  
of R. Garza Survey No 98, (a stake from which  
a L. C. 25" diam. brs. S.  $76\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 35 varas, and  
another 15" br. S.  $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 8 varas.) and also the  
South corner of Fr. Rodriguez Survey No 99  
(a stake from which a L. C. 13" diam. brs. S.  $68\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E.  
4 varas and another 18" diam. brs. N.  $68\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  W.  $1\frac{1}{4}$  varas)  
on the ground, and found them correct,  
and that the South corner of the Fr. Rodriguez  
Survey lies S  $30^{\circ}$  E. 888 varas from the North  
corner of the R. Garza Survey.

The inside sketch is not sufficient to remove objections raised against 484 acres survey file 5-1219 Bexar.

According to field notes V. Bennett 640 a. East corner is identical with the North corner of R. Garcia Francisco Rodrigues begins 1163 vrs S 30 E from said corner and as its West line is 4220 vrs long, by subtraction of Bennett's line = 2202

and the above  $\Rightarrow$  1163. 3365.

A distance is left of 855 vrs from Bennett's North to Rodrigues N. corner, which is represented on the sketch 1040 vrs long.
