Sir, I herewith transmit to you a Copy of the field Notes, of the Surveys, recently made under your order,

Commencing at the south Corner of Sabod N<sup>o</sup> 12 made for B. H. Williams, a Stone Mound from which a Live Oak marked with a blaze by N 33° E 38 bars, Thence N 45° E with south East line of said Sabod, at 1000 bars, found a S O with an old mark x, Thence with south East line of Sabod N<sup>o</sup> 11 N 45° W at 1000 bars, found no sign of a Corner,

Commencing again at south Corner of Sabod N<sup>o</sup> 12, Thence with south East line of N<sup>o</sup> 12, N 45° W at 1000 bars, found no sign of old Corner, at 2000 bars found no Corner, at 3000 bars found Stone Mound with a Live Oak bearing, at 4120 bars found west Corner of Sabod N<sup>o</sup> 15, on the top of a high hill, with a Live Oak bearing marked 21, Thence N 45° E with the south East line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 1 made for Patrick Mc Greal, at 1000 bars, Could not find old Corner, Thence S 45° W with S E line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 1, at 2820 bars found an old Stone Mound without bearings, at 3000 bars Kettle Snakes, at 4770 bars crossed creek Course S E, at 5690 bars found an old Stone Mound without bearings, at 7450 bars to point, Thence S 45° E at 133 bars to Stone Mound the North Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 2 made for Isaac Gowd, Thence S 45° W with N W line of said Survey N<sup>o</sup> 2, at 3073 bars stone mound for west Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 2, a Live Oak 6 in Dia marked x by N 87° W 30 1/2 bars, a Live Oak 5 in Dia marked x by S 48 1/2° W 50 1/2 bars, Thence same Course S 45° W at 2383 bars made Stone on point of hill in forks of Yorks Creek, Thence S 76° W 605 bars to a Stone Mound on East side of high hill, being the West Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 27 and North Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 26, in the S E line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 28 made for J. M. Mlin, a Post Oak 12 in Dia marked P by N 55° W 30 bars, a Post Oak 12 in Dia marked W by N 78° W 35 bars, Thence S 45° W with S E line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 28 at 640 bars crossed Yorks Creek Course S E, at 1300 bars made Stone Mound, with old marked tree, a Live Oak 8 in Dia marked M by S 34 1/2° E 28

a Live Oak 5 in Diam Marked x by  $S 87^{\circ} E 16$  bars, thence with South West line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 28 N $45^{\circ} W$  at 1880 bars Stone Mound a Black Jack 10 in Diam Marked x by  $N 40^{\circ} W 30$  bars, a Black Jack 12 in Diam Marked x by  $N 42^{\circ} E 58$  bars, found an old corner with Black Jack bearings, which by  $N 48^{\circ} E 140$  bars, thence  $N 45^{\circ} E$  at 1285 bars made Stone Mound, a Live Oak 10 in Diam Marked x by  $N 24^{\circ} W 75$  bars, found an old Stone Mound with bearings, which by  $N 32^{\circ} E 150$  bars, thence  $N 45^{\circ} W$  with N<sup>o</sup> 32 line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 32 made for W. W. Albery, at 3988 bars made Stone Mound for North Corner of N<sup>o</sup> 32, on divide of Sew Mar-  
-Cuz & Taudaloupe rivers, an old marked tree a L<sup>o</sup> 15 in Diam Marked x by  $N 20^{\circ} W 30$  bars, another old marked tree, a L<sup>o</sup> 40 in Diam Marked W S by  $N 11^{\circ} W 127$  bars, thence  $S 45^{\circ} W$  with N<sup>o</sup> 32 line of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 32, at 3982 bars made Stone Mound for West Corner of N<sup>o</sup> 32, a L<sup>o</sup> 10 in Diam Marked x by  $S 36^{\circ} E 8$  bars, a L<sup>o</sup> 8 in Diam Marked x by  $N 62^{\circ} W 27$  bars. Could not find old corner, thence  $N 45^{\circ} W 360$  made Stone Mound, thence  $S 22^{\circ} W$  at 1880 bars found Stone Mound for East Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 14 made for S. Kelly, the old cedar bearings have been burnt up, thence  $N 45^{\circ} W$  at 749 bars found a Stone Mound on point of hill, the North Corner of N<sup>o</sup> 14.

Commencing at West Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 18 made for Edward Bullock, a Stone Mound a L<sup>o</sup> 15 in Diam Marked W by  $S 18^{\circ} W 20$  bars, a L<sup>o</sup> 15 in Diam Marked — by  $N 74^{\circ} E 34$  bars, thence  $N 45^{\circ} E 168$  bars made Stone Mound for East Corner N<sup>o</sup> 2 and South Corner N<sup>o</sup> 1, from which an old marked L<sup>o</sup> 10 in Diam Marked L by  $S 86^{\circ} W 48$  bars, a L<sup>o</sup> 12 in Diam Marked x by  $N 83^{\circ} W 61$  bars, thence  $N 45^{\circ} W$  with North East line of N<sup>o</sup> 2 at 6000 bars Stone Mound for North Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 2, a L<sup>o</sup> 20 in Diam Marked x by  $N 51^{\circ} E 51$  bars, a L<sup>o</sup> 10 in Diam Marked x by  $S 48^{\circ} W 85$  bars.

Commencing again at the West Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 18, thence  $N 45^{\circ} W 1600$  bars made Stone Mound for Corner on steep hill side just South of three large rocks, thence South  $45^{\circ} W 2104$  bars to S<sup>o</sup> W Corner of N<sup>o</sup> 2, a Stone Mound, a L<sup>o</sup> 18 in Diam Marked x by  $N 15^{\circ} E 63^{\frac{1}{2}}$  bars, thence  $N 55^{\circ} W 1400$  bars, thence  $S 35^{\circ} W 98$  bars, to an old Stone Mound, found an burnt L<sup>o</sup> about 20 in Diam bearing  $N 4^{\circ} W 74$  bars, corresponding with the North Corner of Survey N<sup>o</sup> 1 made for Saml Craft — as described in the
