Sir, I herewith transmit to you a copy of the field Notes, of the Survey, recently made under your order,

Commencing at the south corner of Labor N°12 made for B. H. Williams, a Stone mound from which a Live Oak marked with a blaze by N 33° E 38 baraz. Thence N 45° E with South East line of said Labor, at 1000 baraz, found a Live Oak with an old mark x. Thence with South East line of Labor N°11 N 45° W at 1000 baraz, found no sign of a corner.

Commencing again at South corner of Labor N°12, Thence with South East line of N°12, N 45° W at 1000 baraz, found no sign of old corner, at 2000 baraz found no corner, at 3000 baraz found Stone Mound with a Live Oak bearing, at 4120 baraz found west corner of Labor N°15, on the top of a high hill, with a Live Oak bearing marked x, Thence N 45° E with the South East line of Survey N°1 made for Patrick Mc Gral, at 1000 baraz, Could not find old corner, Thence S 45° W with S E line of Survey N°1, at 2820 baraz found an old Stone Mound without bearings, at 3000 baraz Nattle Shakes, at 4470 baraz Crooked Creek Course S E, at 5690 baraz found an old Stone Mound without bearings, at 4450 baraz to point, Thence S 45° E at 183 baraz to Stone Mound the North corner of Survey N°2 made for Isaac Dowd, Thence S 45° W with N W line of said Survey N°2, at 3073 baraz stone mound for West corner of Survey N°2, a Live Oak 6 in Diam marked x by N 87° W 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ baraz, a Live Oak 5 in Diam marked x by S 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ baraz, Thence same course S 45° W at 2383 baraz made Stone on point of hill in forks of York Creek, Thence S 45° W 605 baraz to a Stone Mound on East side of high hill, being the West corner of Survey N°27 and North corner of Survey N°26, in the S E line of Survey N°28 made for J. M. Oliver, a Post Oak 12 in Diam marked P by N 55° W 30 baraz, a Post Oak 12 in Diam marked w by N 78° W 35 baraz, Thence S 45° W with S E line of Survey N°28 at 640 baraz crossed Yorks Creek Course & Co. at 1300 baraz made Stone Mound, an old marked tree, a Live Oak 8 in Diam marked m by S 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E 28

at Nine Oaks 5 m Diam Marked X by $58^{\circ}E$ 16 barsaz.
Thence with South West line of Survey N° 28 $N45^{\circ}W$ at
1880 barsaz Stone mound a Black Jack 10 in Diam Marked
X by $840^{\circ}W$ 30 barsaz, a Blackjack 12 in Diam Marked X by
 $N42^{\circ}E$ 58 barsaz, found an old Corner with Blackjack
bearings, which has $N48^{\circ}E$ 140 barsaz, Thence $N45^{\circ}E$
at 1285 barsaz made Stone Mound, a Nine Oak 10 m Diam Marked
X by $N24\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}W$ 15 barsaz, found an old Stone mound with bearing,
which has $N32^{\circ}E$ 150 barsaz, Thence $N45^{\circ}W$ with NW line
of Survey N° 32 made for W. W. Albury, at 3882 barsaz made
Stone Mound for North Corner of N° 32, on divide of Sow Mar-
g & Iaudaloupe River, an old marked tree, a Ld O 12 m Diam
Marked X by $N20^{\circ}W$ 30 bz, another old marked tree, a Ld O 40 m
Diam Marked W.S. by $N1\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}W$ 127 bz, Thence $S45^{\circ}W$
with NW line of Survey N° 32, at 3932 barsaz made Stone
Mound for West Corner of N° 32, a Ld O 10 m Diam Marked
X by $S36\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 8 barsaz, a Ld O 8 m Diam Marked X by $S62\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$
 $27\frac{1}{2}bz$. Could not find old corner, Thence $N45^{\circ}W$ 360
made Stone Mound, Thence $S23\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ at 1880 barsaz found
Stone mound for East Corner of Survey N° 14 Made for P.
S. Kelly, the old Cedar bearings have been burnt up, Thence
 $N45^{\circ}W$ at 149 barsaz found a Stone Mound on point of hill,
the North Corner of N° 14.

Commencing at West Corner of Survey N° 18 made for
Edward Bullock, a Stone Mound a Ld O 15 m Diam Marked
W by $S18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 20 barsaz, a Ld O 15 m Diam Marked — by
 $N14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 34 barsaz, Thence $N45^{\circ}E$ 968 barsaz made Stone
Mound for East Corner N° 2 and South Corner N° 1, from
which an old Marked Ld O 10 m Diam Marked L by $S36^{\circ}W$
45 barsaz, a Ld O 12 m Diam Marked X by $N83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 61 bz.
Thence $N45^{\circ}W$ with North East line of N° 2 at 6000 barsaz
Stone mound for North Corner of Survey N° 2, a Ld O 20 m Diam
Marked X by $N51^{\circ}E$ 51 barsaz, a Ld O 10 m Diam Marked X by
 $S49\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 85 barsaz —

Commencing again at the West Corner of Survey
N° 18, Thence $N45^{\circ}W$ 1600 barsaz made Stone mound for
Corners on Steep hill side just South of three large rocks.
Thence South $45^{\circ}W$ 2104 barsaz to S.W. Corner of N° 2, a Stone
mound, a Ld O 18 m Diam Marked X by $N15\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ bz,
Thence $N55^{\circ}W$ 1400 barsaz, Thence $S35^{\circ}W$ 48 barsaz, to an
old Stone Mound, found ~~opp~~ a burnt Ld O about 20 m
Diam bearing $N40^{\circ}W$ 74 bz, Corresponding with the North Corner
of Survey N° 1 made for Saml. Craft — as described in the
