 Dumb Asylum and Corner No 16 for

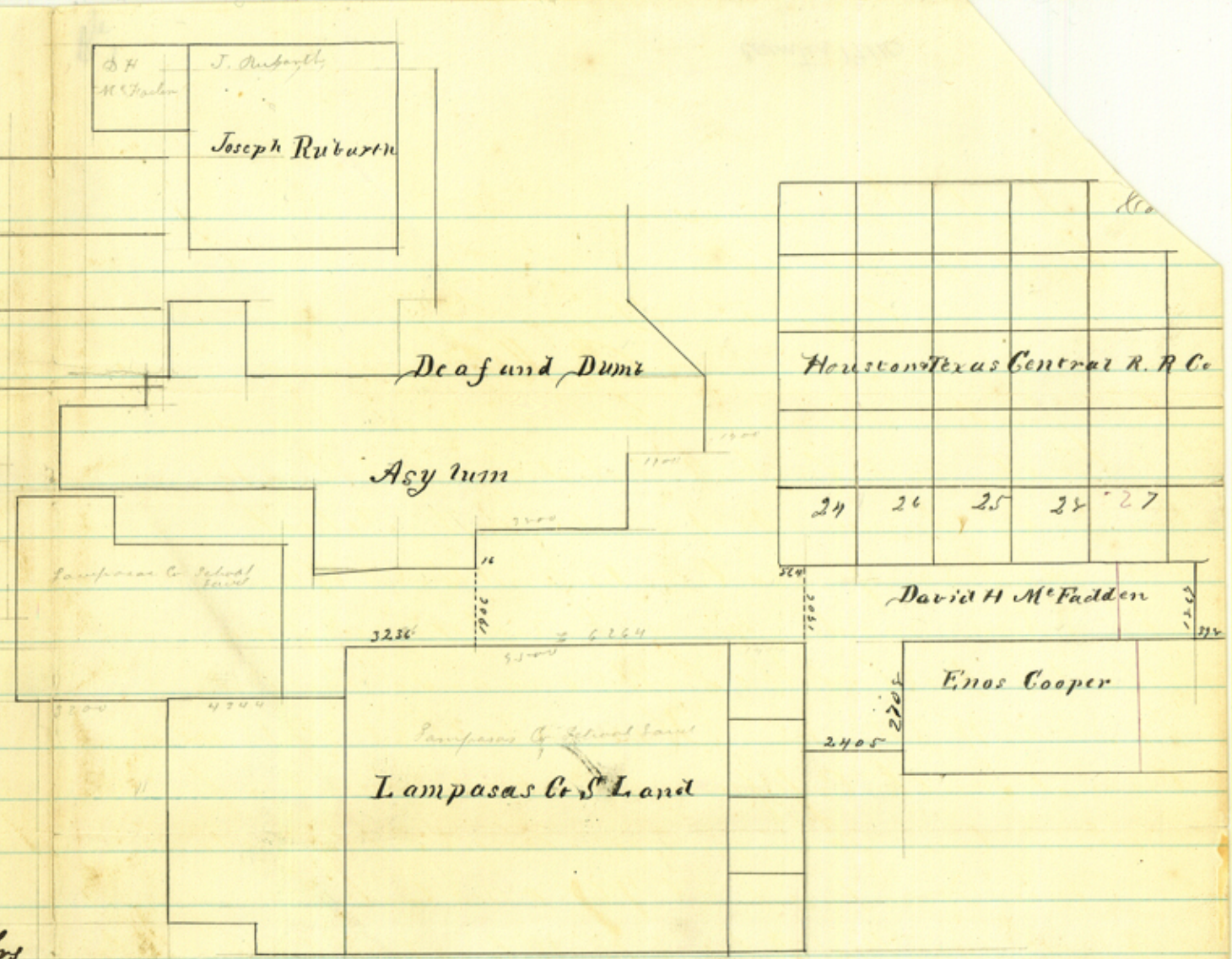
