Dear Sir:

I am enclosing herewith a blue print you will notice on this print lines mkd ~~xxx~~ thus, in Red Ink. I would thank you to have prepared a complete work sketch of the territory inside of the red xed. lines. This sketch is for the Swenson Brothers whose Poyue River Ranch includes the major part of lands included. Let the sketch be most complete, showing all natural and artificial objects called for also dates of the original surveys and by whom made and variations recorded. Block G. - H & G. N. R. R. Co. as resurveyed by State Surveyor Kenney was based on original S.W. Cor. of # 2, which is well identified on the ground. (I have been at that corner). Also I have examined S.W. corner of 15 cent 182 of H. Gibson and ran a connecting line to S.W. Cor. of 2. Bl. G. and found it as represented by Kenney. Have sketch show the conflicts of 182 T. W. N. S. R. R. and 182. B. S. & F. with Block G. - H & G. N. R. R. Co.

I am going to cut up the Swenson lands into quarter sections. There has been considerable ^{bother} ^{about these lines} lines and I want to put corners that will stand all tests. Mr. H. von Rosenberg understands the situation and if there is any other surveys needed to be added I want him to have them included. I have Kenney's connecting lines and state map. Would thank you to have this sketch prepared as quickly as possible. Send bill to me and I will send draft or P.O. money order at once.

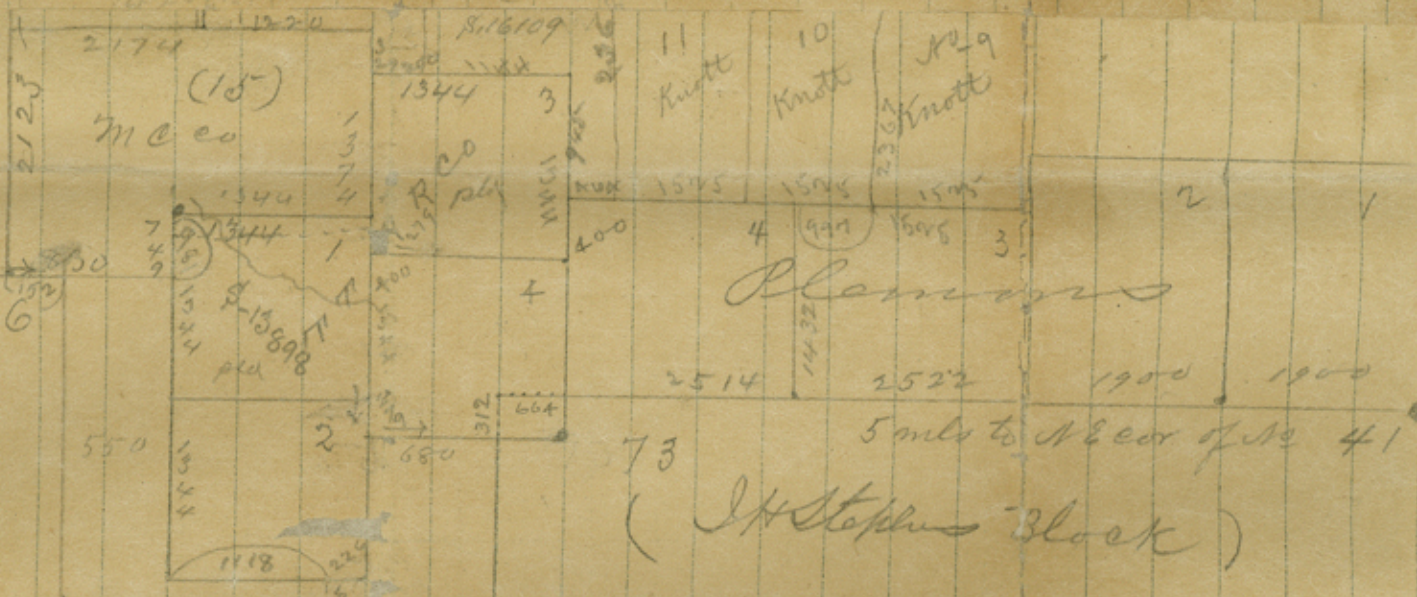
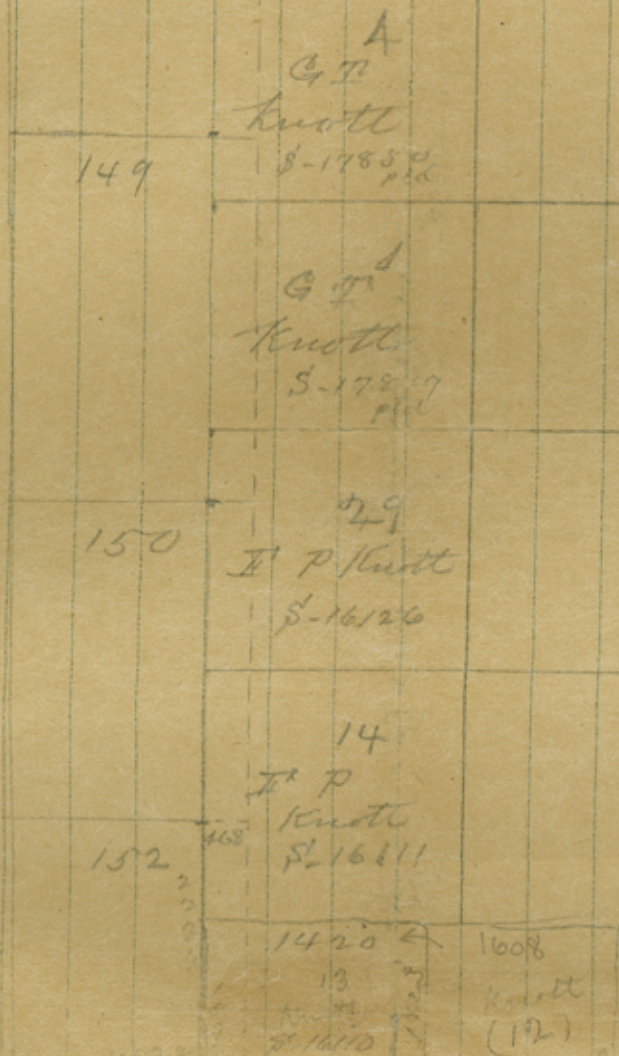

Before Corrected field notes are returned for Matador Co
Co surveys No 149, 150 + 152, f. 17478-9 + 17481,
in Motley Co, the Surveyor should go to the NE cor
of No 24 J H Stephens in Cattle Co, which is a lot
wood N 58 1/2 W E 280 r, also called for by J P
Knott sur No 1 at its SE cor; and measure
West + South to SE cor of No 4 Tyler Tap, or
to NW cor of No 1 Tyler Tap, and thence
to NE + SE cor of No 5 Georgetown RR Co,
also all witnessed corners; These measurements
will show whether or not there would be
any conflict on the ground between the
said No 149, 150 + 152 with the Knott
surveys, and whether or not No 15 Matador
Co (in which No 152 begins), conflicts
with No 1 Tyler Tap, as shown by
Connections on E B line of Motley Co,
from No 2 Tyler Tap to NE cor of No
2 Matador Cattle Co. It is shown
by Connections of Neff + Ross, that there is 432 r
excess in No 24 J H Stephens and the apparent
conflict of the surveys No 152, 150 + 149 M Co with
the Knott surveys is by calculation 468 r, so
it will be seen that to construct the Knott + from
said cor of No 24 by Course + dist, allowing
said excess in Stephens Block, the Conflict would
be reduced to 36 r. Hence the necessity
of Surveyor going on the ground. 2/1/95

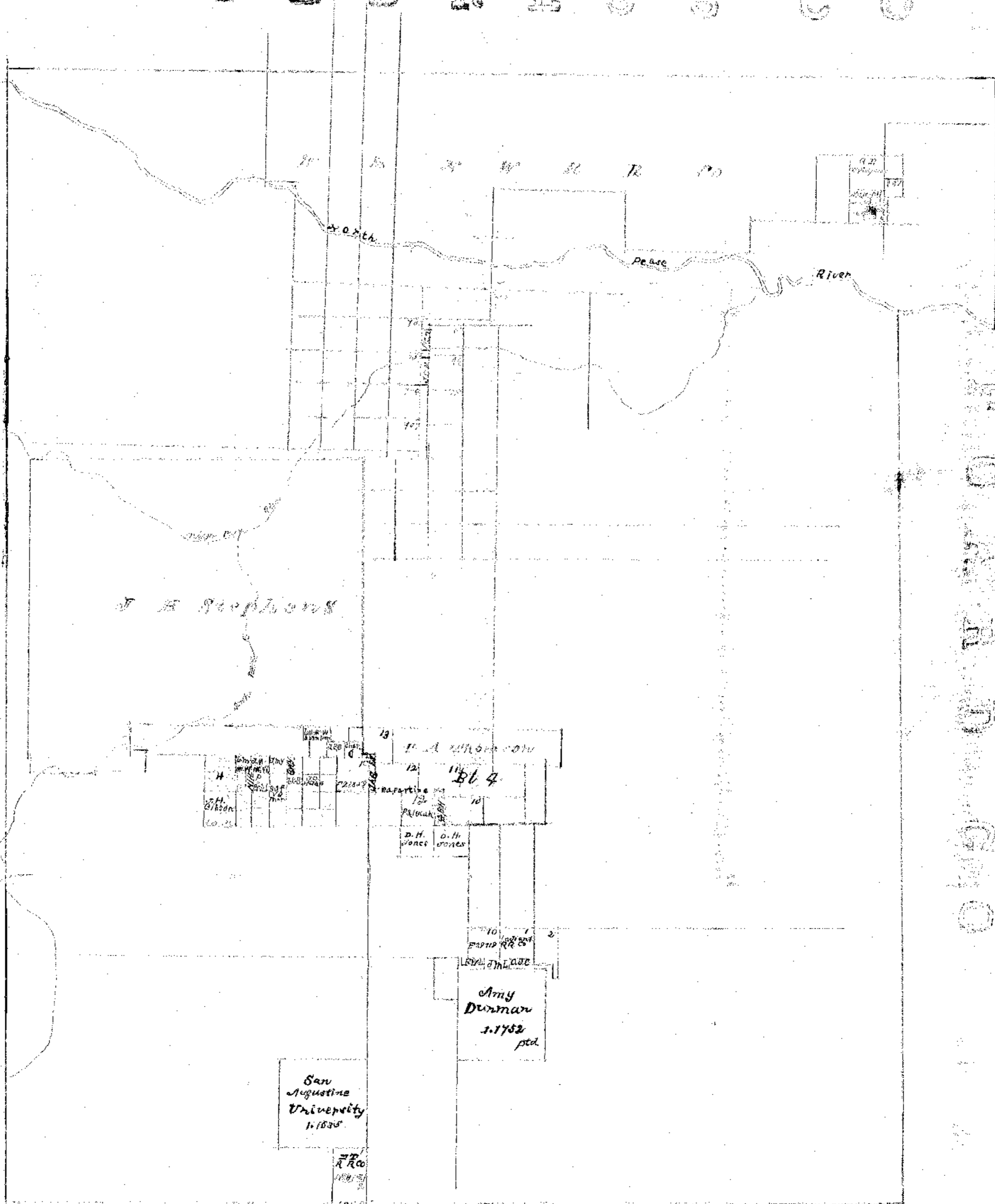
