Dear Sir:-

The following is the condensed field notes of a survey made for T. G. Hendricks in Crane Co. Tex. July 28th 1900. Showing connection between Bk. 7 - C. C. S. D. R. 4: 7: 9; and the N. & T. C. B. 2.

Beg. at N.W. cor. sur. 89. a rock and outlet stone from which a rod of rk. on top of ledge br. S 15° E. - and pt of a ledge of rock N 80 1/2° E. (established Oct 4th 1881) -

Thence N. 13° W 1900.8 vs. a stk & rod rock. from wh each rocky pt of rock mountain br. S 18° 35' E. about 1/4 mile dist. - S.E. cor. 17 BX -

Thence S 77° W at 1900.8 vs. a megal stk. S.W. 17.

Thence S 77° W. 1900.8 vs. a stk and rock and. north side fence 13 vs.

Thence S 77° W. 1900.8 vs. S.W. cor. 35.

Thence S 77° W. 1900.8 vs. a pt on north line 74.

Thence S 77° W. 1900.8 vs. apt

Thence S 77° W. at 406 vs. meet n. line H and T. C. B. 2. sur. 32. a rod of rock and stk. from wh S. pt of north cattle mt. - on north side gap. br. N. 55° E. and south pt south cattle mt br. S 83° E. another mt br. S 40° W.

Thence N. 5-0° W. 618 vs. - to the N.W. cor sur. 32 a stone and etc.

I send these field notes to compare with the notes I sent in some time ago. to see if they agree. both copies are from the same original notes. These are a little brief.
