Dear Sir:

Under instructions from your office, I am making this report covering my survey of section 80, Block X, Crane County, Texas, and my findings of other surveys surrounding Section Eighty (80).

I commenced my survey at the corner of secs. 1, 18, 81 and 88 of said Block X, which is a mound of sandstone on a large flat rock, with mountain bearings, which check very close, from this corner.

I run N. 15° 05' W. along the East Bdy. of section 18 and at 1921.5 Varas Fall 14.9 varas East of a mound of stone and Iron pipe; this, however, is not an original corner; the original corner was a large rock set in the ground, which has been destroyed, and at 3876.0 Varas Fall 5.5 Varas West of the old original corner of secs. 2, 3, 16 and 17, which is a mound of stone, with mountain bearings which check. This corner is in a flat where there are no stones, except those in the mound for corner.

The true course of this line is therefore  
N. 15° 00' W.

From the original corner of secs. 2, 3, 16 and 17 I run the lines between secs. 16 and 17 and between secs. 20 and 21 and found the old original stone mounds as shown on my sketch plat submitted with the field notes of sec. 80 and shown on tracing submitted herewith.

I also run the lines between secs. 20 and 35 and between secs. 19 and 76 as shown on original sketch and field notes and tracing herewith.

From the corner of secs. 1, 18, 81 and 88 heretofore described

I run the line between secs. 81 and 88 as shown on sketch and tracing, giving the line between said sections the same distance as I found the length of the lines between secs. 1 and 18 and 2 and 17.

I wish to call particular attention to the conflict between my survey of the line between secs. 81 and 88 and the Estes survey of said line. Mr. Estes makes the length of this line 2032.0 Varas. I made it 1938.0 Varas. I did not find the original corner of secs. 81, 82, 85 and 88, but found parts of the little Brown Jug set in the ground for the original corner close to where I set my corner and placed my corner of said sections at a point 22 Varas from an old Road crossing the line N. of the Cor. This road also crosses the S. Bdy. of Sec. 81 as surveyed by me at 99 varas from my corner. The old original notes give this Road at practically as I found it.

Attached hereto is a copy of my field notes of said sec. 80 with sketch and tracing of said survey showing the location of the corners set by Estes conflicting with my survey which are made a part of this report.

In making the survey of section 80, I conformed with the old original corners.
