please find notes of connection between Willow Springs & Howards Well which connection seriously affects the present map of Crockett County

The connection between Willow Springs & Beaver Lake I made in July 1879 & found it correct - or nearly so.

I also connected the S.W. corner of sur no 4 block M. N. E. C. & S. H. R. N. Co. an Johnsons Run work done through Mad- dex & Bros, with Willow Springs the field notes of which are herein enclosed

I also connected the S.W. corner of Runnel Co. survey no 1 with Willow Springs

I enclose no field-notes of this connection
as its position on map is correct;

I run numerous other connecting lines
and found no corners.

I run a line 25 miles north of a
joint-corner East of the North East corner of
Survey no 7. McMullen Co School Land.

On this line I crossed head waters of Dove
Creek passed apparently about 2 miles West
of main creek which I run north about 25 East
I found no corners.

I connected with a corner about 3 miles
~~North of North line of North of N. W. corner of~~
Survey no 7 McMullen Co. School Land corner was
on East side of Devils River but is not reported
I suppose it to be an abandoned corner of
made by Adj. Stornis

I run a line ^{about 12 miles} on a North Westward
course from Howards Well, I am satisfi-
ed no very serious error exist in connection
between Howards Well & Ft Lancaster.

I have made no connection between
Brewer Lake Survey and those from Ft
Tennet but will shortly

I have reason to believe that the Survey
on Devils River extend up too far rather
than those from Low Green Co. extends down
