

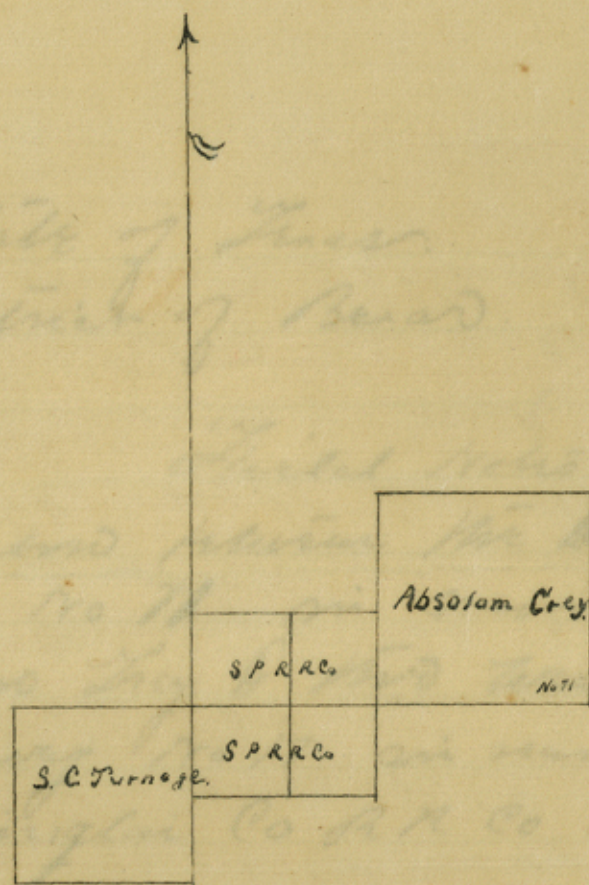

 corner of Survey No 71
 Traced west at 1900 yards
 then around at 3300 yards
 then around 4 ft. high on
 head of a hillside. A line cut
 it on the top west 30 yards
 a line cut 700 yards west

Field Notes of a
live road between the N.W. cor-
ner of Survey No 71 in name of
Abraham Key & the West corner
of Survey No 17 in name of
Washington Co RR Co on South
Llano.

Beginning at the N.W.
corner of Survey No 71. a stone
mark in valley that runs
N.W. corner South Prong of North
Llano. A live oak 6 in dia
marked \bar{x} to South 85 varas
Another 8 in dia to N 31 E 194 varas
Thence South @ 2342 varas
Stone mark in hollow @ 4442
Stone mark on ^{South} edge of divide
A small live oak 4 in dia to
N 41 E 24 varas. marked for S.W.
corner of Survey No 71
Thence West at 1900 varas
Stone mark at 3800 varas
Stone mark 4 ft high in
prick of a hollow. A live oak
18 in dia to West 35 varas
A live oak 7 in dia to S 24 E 11 varas

march for NW NE corner of
Survey No 78 in named of S.E.
Turnings.

Turned South crossing over
a Dead Level Plain 3600 yards
to a Stone mound on South
Side of a live oak timber
a live oak tree in the 3400
22 yards a live oak 8 in dia
by S 78 E 42 yards. march for
S.W. corner of Survey No 78.

Turned South crossing across
of South Land hollow that
run S.W. @ 400 yards stand
mound in north of bushes.
500 yards mound on slope
of hill.

Turned South crossing hollow
@ 1920 yards stand mound 3 ft
high on Point @ 2640 yards
Stone mound on Point. Cedar 8
in by 850r 28 yards. Turned
South crossing mesquit valley @
10800 in ^{McKungis} route to
Fort McKavett to Fort Clark @
10800 in McKungis Creek @ 5040
yards stand in valley of South
Land. Turned S 82 1/2 W crossing

South Land 1052 versus 10 a line
mound. L.O. 12 in dia by S 9° E 64 m.
Another line oak 18 in dia by
S 12° E 60 versus made for the
Washington County Rail Road.

Therefore making it evident
from the above connection
that the N.W. corner of the
Absalom Day Survey No 71 is
18745 yards from E 4794 yards
East of the West corner of
Survey No 17 W.C. R.R. Co.
