

Fieldnotes of a connecting line run from the
S. E. corner of Survey No 24 and S. W. corner of survey No 23
Block A. Gulf West Texas & Pacific Rail road Company
Cert. No. 1192 in Crockett County on Epps or Viejo Creek a
tributary of North Llano river to S. E. corner of Bend and
Fortsch 320 acres survey at Willow Spring on Devils river
in Crockett County

Beginning at the S. W. corner of said survey No 23
Blk. A. a rock mound about 4000rs West of Epps Cr, rebuilt
same and mkd. cap rock or slab (S. W. cor. No 23) with black
paint, both Live Oak bearings still standing and identified
by Jacob Kuechler the original locator, L. O. 5" in dia. brs.
S 1° W 120rs, another 7" in dia. brs N 64° W 310rs.

Thence N 70 1/2° W crossing draws of North Llano several
times, rocky, good grass, Live Oak & cedar, no water, at
16400rs cross draw of North Llano, at 16600rs good roll
ing country, at 18200rs to 20500rs cross draws of San
Saba river several times, at 22510rs a point.

Thence West at 1800rs cross road course South, at 2000rs
another road course South from Taylors well to M^c. Kavett,
large open prairie South and S. W., at 5600rs large
dry pond about 100rs North, at 6600rs cross dry pond, at
8000 to 10400rs cross draws of San Saba three times, at
10600rs low rocky ridge, cedar & L. O., at 13710rs cross
road course S. E. at 15445rs cross road course S. E.
from M^c. Neill well to Taylors well, at 16590rs cross road
to M^c. Neill's wells in all 16780rs a point.

No. 44 as established by N. H. Bonnell distant North 280 vrs and East 190 vrs, another rock mound 2 1/2 feet high bears West 76 1/2 vrs and North 3 vrs, marked (S. E. cor. No. 33 J. T. B.) from which 2 L. O. 6th brs. S. 38 1/2 W 8 & 8 1/2 vrs another 6th brs N 48 1/2 W 26 vrs, mkd. $\frac{x}{\equiv}$ for J. T. Brackeunige, Another rock mound 3 feet high bears West 1219 vrs and North 446 vrs, a large slab in center mkd. (S. W. cor. No. 43) built by Frank Vickery for M^{rs}. Neill, (Good agricultural land for small grain extends many miles North, South, S. E. & N. W. no water, good grass, scattering live oak and mesquite, good water can be had by drilling wells at 360 to 400 feet.)

Thence East 190 vrs a point

Thence North 280 vrs to aforesaid rock & cedar post set by Bonnell for S. W. cor. No. 43 & S. E. cor. No. 44.

Thence West at 95 1/2 vrs a rock md. 2 1/2 feet high bears South 27 vrs, mkd. (S. E. cor. No. 33 J. T. B.) continued West at 1409 vrs a rock md. 3 feet high bears North 166 vrs and mkd. (S. W. cor. No. 43.) continued West at 10800 vrs enter valley course W. of S. at 11200 vrs cross deep dry Creek, at 11275 vrs out of valley, at 13000 vrs enter valley, at 13300 vrs cross large dry river bed known as Coucho draw of Devils river which forms Elbow or Kuechler lake, at 13860 vrs & 13980 vrs cross road from Fort Coucho to Del Rio, course from N. S. with valley, at 14000 vrs out of valley, at 14422 vrs a point on ridge overlooking a valley South & S. W.

Thence S. 72 W at 400 vrs enter valley course S. E., at 2400 vrs valley come in from N. W. & S. W., at 4000 vrs out of valley, rocky ridge (valley 1/2 mile wide) 4280 vrs into small valley 5500 vrs a point

Thence S 9° W. 2048 vrs to a large L.O. tree on ridge a point,
from which Ed. Wall spring or well brs. East 2080 vrs and
S 5 1/2° E 280 vrs.

Thence S 45° W 1100 vrs into valley, at 2600 vrs low rocky ridge,
at 3760 vrs cross Creek course S. little W, at 6040 vrs valley of
Creek (4500 vrs wide) and extend South ~~east~~ ^{west} rocky ridges,
good grass white and black gamma, curly mesquite, at
24000 vrs enter canon of big Devils river, down said
Creek at 25180 vrs passed a rock mound 2 1/2 feet high about
60 to 80 vrs S.E. of line the S.E. corner of Ed. J. Blackey
survey upon which Willow Spring is situated, at 25320 vrs.

river, about 100 vrs above large dry water hole in bed of river.

Thence N 26° E 3388 vrs up valley to a point in channel
of Devils river near foot of Mountain, large valley West.

Thence S 61 3/4° E 29 vrs to foot of Willow tree at Willow Spring
now dry, situated on the Ed. J. Blackey survey

Thence S 1/4° E 512 vrs to the S.E. corner of Survey No 1 in the
name of Ferd Fretsch an old dead Mesquite stump 5" in
