

Connecting line run from Kueckler's on
Elbow Lake to the large Live Oak tree in
the forks of Devils River the bearing tree
for the S.E. corner of sur. no. 17 & S.W. cor.
sur. no. 16 Block "C" G. W. T & P. R. R. Co.

Monday October 3rd 1898 at noon.

Beginning at the intersection of the West and
East prongs or Coules & Lano forks of the East
fork of Devils river at a point ^{in the elbow} from
which the S.W. corner of survey no. 3 Rusk
Transportation Co. bears $S45^{\circ}W$ 950 vars.
Thence $S88^{\circ}W$ at 100 vars East fork to the
right, at 145 vars. a point, East fork abt. 50 vars.
to the right -

Thence $S72\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ at 220 vars cross main fork
course S of W (or $S58^{\circ}W$) to left, at 1420 vars to a
L.O. tree for point -

Thence $S70^{\circ}W$ at 1010 vars. cross Gillespie's pasture
fence, at 1800 vars cross a cut off of Giest's draw
course S of W at 1890 vars to a large L.O. tree on bank
of Giest's draw, at 1895 vars center of main
channel of said prong course South at 2000
vars. a point.

Thence $S75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ at 470 vars enter small field
(Gillespie's) at 605 vars leave same, at 680 vars
off set $N14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 40 vars to avoid a large tank
of water, continued $S75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 280 vars. point, off
set back $S14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 40 vars in all 960 vars. in
Gillespie lot, 6 vars North of his well & Windmill
Thence $S75^{\circ}W$ passing between his home and barn
at 1330 vars center of East fork of Devils river
C. N of W. 1680 vars point.

Tuesday October 4th / 98

Thence $S64^{\circ}W$ at 300 vs cross East fork C. S.W.
 at 330 vs cross road, 450 vs we cross C. S.W.
 at 1880 vs cross same road C. West at 2189 vs to
 L.O. tree ^{about 15 vs below crossing of road} on East bank of Sellers draw, corner
 of draw S.W. into East fork.

Thence $S69^{\circ}W$ at 140 vs. a point on line from
 which a draw called Babbs ^{draw} coming into
 East fork from the South brs $S24^{\circ}E$ abt 200 vs.
 dit. continuing $S69^{\circ}W$ at 367 vs cross ^{same} road
 C. S.W. at 378 vs cross John Potters new fence
 water hole abt. 30 vs South, and a gate abt. 60 vs
 South, at 2365 vs. cross draw C. S.W. at 2800
 vs. point, East fork to the left.

Thence $S64^{\circ}W$ at 920 vs cross East fork (to right)
 1085 vs. cross small pasture fence C. E & W (at
 2360 vs a point from which the S.W. corner of
 half section No 8 shown us by John Potter residing
 on said section brs. $S74^{\circ}E$ 107 vs. from which
 Mesqt. brs $S86^{\circ}W$ 15 vs. another Mesqt. $N50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 25 vs.)
 continued $S64^{\circ}W$ at 2980 vs. cross East fork C.
 S.W. (to left) at 2960 vs to 3090 vs in River
 and leaving same, at 3920 vs cross draw ^{East fork} C. S.W.
 4340 vs. point.

Thence $S63^{\circ}W$ at 340 vs pass a rock ind. 1 vs. to
 the right, at 520 vs to 640 vs. in river leaving
 same to right, at 680 vs. a L.O. tree for point,
 22 inches in diameter mk'd. M old mk'd. new mk's.
 above \bar{x} .

Thence South 40 vs. to a point for clear
 running, large water hole abt. 340 vs S. E.
 under a bluff.

Thence $S43^{\circ}W$ at 300 vs. cross draw c. North into
East fork, at 527 vs cross road (to right) at 1080
vs. draw coming into East fork from N.W. East
fork distant to right abt. 300 vs. at 1200
vs. a point & camped.

Wednesday October 5th/98-

Thence $S71^{\circ}W$ 1120 to 1280 vs with East fork
to a point in East fork.

Thence $S74^{\circ}W$ with river at 73 vs cross wire
fence c N & S. at 350 vs leave river, at
1600 vs point -

Thence $S69^{\circ}W$ at abt. 2500 vs cross road (to left)
at 2800 vs. point from which Wind Mill br $S21^{\circ}W$

Thence $S45^{\circ}W$ 1200 vs. a point, fr. wh. Wind
Mill br. $S27^{\circ}E$ -

Thence $S39\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 2125 vs to a large Live
Oak tree 36 in. diameter marked \bar{X} on
S.E. side in Forks of Devils river and bear
ing tree for S.E. cor. No. 17 & S.W. cor. No. 16
and being the same tree connected to by
D. Donaldson in August 1884.

Thence East from said S.O. 79 vs. to a point
in the East line of Survey no. 17 & West line
of No. 16 Blk G. of W.T. & P. Ry Co.

Thence North with said line 1227 vs. to
old stone mound, ^{center rock} mk'd. NW 16 from which a dead
Mesq. 4" $S78^{\circ}E$ 12 vs. another Mesq. 6" $N8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 250 vs.
old marks \bar{X}

Thence $N\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ at 500 vs cross big Devils river
at 2111 vs. to old stone mound in dry bed
of Devils river, center rock mk'd NE 20, being
the N.E. cor. of sur. 20 & N.W. cor. sur. no. 21.

Block "G" G.W.T. & P. Ry Co.

Thence East 1900 vrs point for N. E. cor. of sec. no. 21 on top of high hill between the East fork and main Devils river overlooking both valleys, from this point for N. E. corner of No. 21 we ran East 11,400 vrs as follows:

Thursday October 6th 1908

Began at the point on hill for N. E. cor. sec. 21, Thence East down steep bluff into East fork of Devils river at 940 vrs cross East fork, 1120 vrs point in ~~said~~ valley (offset to right or South 200 vrs a point -)

Thence East 2000 vrs ^{point} on top of hill or ridge, East fork to the North.

Thence East at 390 vrs cross draw C. North, at 960 vrs cross fence 2000 vrs a point.

Thence East 2000 vrs a point in valley (East fork abt. 3/4 mile North) Thence off set back on line North 200 vrs.

Thence East at 640 vrs cross a large draw C. North into East fork, ^{at} 900 vrs in valley 1280 vrs cross pasture fence C. N & S. at 2000 vrs a point.

Thence East at 1960 vrs. cross road E. of North at 2280 vrs a point on top of high hill, this being the termination of the 11,400 vrs as called for in field notes of sec. no. 3 Park Transportation Co. and as being 950 vrs S 45 W. from ~~the~~ the junction of middle prong and South prong of East fork of Devils river.

South or S. &
said terminating point is distant from
the nearest point on East fork of Devils
river over two miles (see map accom-
panying this report)

Beginning at the point of termination
thence $N40^{\circ}W$ 1660 vs. a point on
hill from which John Patten Windmill
bears $N15^{\circ}W$.

Thence $N15^{\circ}W$ 1950 vs. to John Patten well
in center of Wind Mill tower at the foot
of hill on South side of valley of East
fork of Devils river,

Thence $S83^{\circ}W$ 872 vs. to the S.W. corner
of $\frac{1}{2}$ Section No. 8 as claimed by John Patten
and connected to by us on Tuesday 4th
Oct/98 (in the course $S64^{\circ}W$ at 2360 vs and $S74^{\circ}E$
107 vs.)
