S. F. R. R. Co., and terminating at
a point in a Connecting Line 7375
varas due W of the S.E. corner of
survey No 25, Block S.T., Cert. No
1295, H. E. and W. T. R. R. Co.

Said Line is in Crockett Co, Tex-
as, beginning at a point in the E
line of survey No 31, Block M,
Cert. No. $\frac{4}{1284}$, S. C. and S. F. R. R. Co.
1668ms. N of its S. E. corner, which
point I examined and identified to
be the same as described in the
original Field Notes for the S. W.
corner of survey No. 7, Block I,
Cert. No. $\frac{4}{1401}$, S. C. and S. F. R. R. Co.
more fully described as follows: "A
point from which a Live Oak 12
inches in diameter marked "D" bears
S 16 W 74 ms., a live oak stump bears
N 71 W 42 ms., a live oak stump
bears S 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 47 ms., a clump of
small Live Oak bushes bears S 14 E
51 ms."

Thence N 232 ms a rock mound.

Thence W 5700ms a large rock mound.

Thence N 2118ms to a point in a Connecting Line 7375ms due W of the S.E. corner of survey No. 25, Block S.T. Cert. No. 1295, H. E. and W. T. R. R. Co, the S.E. corner of said survey No. 25, being marked by a rock monument 3 feet high from which a Live Oak ~~marked~~ 15 inches in diameter bears $N 2\frac{1}{4}W$ 126ms.

Surveyed August 26, 1903, magnetic variation $9^{\circ} 38'$ East, being the variation required to strike the original corners in this (Block N) and adjoining Blocks.
