I have also resurveyed Block B and the sections to the north and east, and I will be able to forward a full report soon. This map is sent to inquire particularly about the interests of Mrs. M. L. Hillis, a widow, who through her own efforts; s is caring for a large family out of the resource she has in the A. L. Owan survey. which is covered in part by a lake basin. The D. P. Allen is identified by old stone corners which were placed at an early date and whichn fit with unusualix accuracy the bearing calls for the Allen well and with less accuracy the bearing calls for the Standifer well, both of which are indicated on map.
