Dear Sir:-

Enclosed I am handing you a ~~blue~~ print which indicates the resurvey I have made in Crosby County covering the homesteads shown. I have also resurveyed Block B and the sections to the north and east, and I will be able to forward a full report soon. This map is sent to inquire particularly about the interest of Mrs. M. L. Hillis, a widow, who through her own efforts, is caring for a large family out of the resource she has in the A. L. Owan survey, which is covered in part by a lake basin. The D. P. Allen is identified by old stone corners which were placed at an early date and which fit with unusually accuracy the bearing calls for the Allen well and with less accuracy the bearing calls for the Standifer well, both of which are indicated on map. The Owan survey calls for Section # 4 on the West, and if run out from the calls for # 4, would include 150 varas on the West and 96.6 varas on the South of the position indicated on the map. Mrs. Hillis is very anxious to include this land if she is entitled to it under the calls in her field notes. If she is not entitled to it under her field notes, she would like to purchase it from the State. Mr. S. U. Payne had an application, which covered this land, and I understand from him that he does not object to Mrs. Hillis procuring the land which joins her.

I should have written you a week ago but I had no detailed sketch prepared so I must defer completing my report until I can receive full details instructions for ~~ax~~ constructing A. L. Owen
