Dear Mr. Farmer:

In accordance with our conference of today relative to the construction to be adopted in the resurvey of Blocks 65 and 78, Public School Land, located in Culberson County, I believe the decision reached should be satisfactory to all parties concerned.

It was decided that corners set by Frank F. Friend for the SW corner and the SE corner of State University Land Blk. 48 and found upon the ground, be adopted for the NE corner and the NW corner of Blk. No. 65, P.S.L.:

That the SW corner of Blk. No. 78 be located from the NE corner of Blk. 65, Tsp. 10, T. & P. R.R. Co. in accordance with the call in the field notes of Survey No. 48, Blk. 64, for its SE corner and SW corner of Blk. 78:

That the SE corner of Blk. No. 78 be established at a point 6 miles due east from the SW corner of Blk. 78 as described above. The west boundary lines of Blocks 65 and 78, Public School Lands, will then be a continuous line connecting the SW corner of State University Blk. 48 as set by F.F. Friend and the corner established for the SW corner of Blk. 78 and the east boundary lines of Blocks 65 and 78, Public School Lands, will be a continuous line from the SE corner of State University Land Blk. 48 to the corner set for the SE corner of Blk. No. 78 at a point 6 miles due east from the SW corner of Blk. 78 as established from the NE corner of Sec. 1, Blk. 65, Tsp. 10, T. & P. R.R. Co.

From this construction it will be observed that no excess distance exists in Blocks 65 and 78, P.S.L., east and west.

The boundary line between Blocks 65 and 78, P.S.L., shall then be located midway between F.F. Friend's SE corner of State University Blk. 48 and the SE corner of Blk. No. 78, P.S.L., and a line produced due west to intersect the west boundary line of Blocks 65 and 78, P.S.L., as established and described above.

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Such excess as is found north and south in these two blocks shall then be equally distributed. In this manner, all of the surveys in the two blocks will have the same acreage with the exception of the sections in the North tier of Blk. 65, which will be short to the extent of the conflict by State University Block No. 48.
