Attached hereto please find my statement for work done on application to purchase numbered S.F.15264, in the name of J.B.Walling. After compiling all available data from the General Land Office and from private sources, and going over the matter with Mr. Walling, he has expressed a desire to withdraw his application.

For your records my findings are as follows:

1. Jacob Kuechler originally surveyed the T.&P. Blocks bounding this file on the North.
2. Paul McCombs later re-surveyed said T. & P. Blocks, and his work was adopted by Court Judgement.
3. Maps of a later survey made by the T. & P., showing all necessary information, are in my possession.
4. Block 46, University Land was originally surveyed by Dennis Corwin.
5. Mr. Corwin placed one corner on the ground, from which the University Land should be located, and in so doing placed the North line of said University Land some 200 varas in conflict with the T. & P. Block to the North.
6. Public School Land Blocks 47, 68, and 69, build off the N.W. corner of said Block 46, University Land, which also places them in conflict with the T. & P. Blocks to the North.
