Inclosed I send you corrected
 field notes of L B Tallaferra # 7 Mrs M A Willis # 1
 J P Bailey # 2 & Mrs E Everett # 2 all in
 Dallam County, also map marked "Exhibit A"
 which shows above surveys with their connection
 with surrounding surveys & old corners

You can see from old corners shown & connections made with
 them that I did not spare trouble & work to get the sur-
 rounding blocks correct on the ground

Note that the work on East has 36' heavier variation than
 the other old blocks. To N O Bk's 7 T & 1 T, ^{& of course C.T. Bl 1 A also} stand alone
 on this end of the country as having more than a half degree
 heavier variation than any other work

I found south line of H & J C Bk 47 1/2 & N line of
 Bk 48 to be parallel & both 36' lighter variation.

H & J C Blk 44 is practically same or 1 or 2 minutes
 still less variation. I have corrected my variation to correspond
 with U.S meridian established by coast survey at Channing
 Blocky Stake & Forward Bl 1 & B & B Bl 1 were evidently never
 surveyed on the ground originally or if so, both being
 for most part in heavy sand all traces of an orig
 sur. have been obliterated.

I ~~made~~ made the East line of B D & F Bl 1 at a
 right angle to Block line of 47 1/2 with which it ties on the
 north & my connection with Sec 16 Blk 48 was just as shown on map.

The connection with Sec 21 Bl 48 is as made from SW Cor Columbus
 Tap Blk 1 a, same being established by intersecting the block lines.

I am thoroughly satisfied in my own mind that I have
 these Block lines correct & I hope your office will
 so see it and accept & finally dispose of these
 surveys. In addition, several different settlers
 on B D & F Bl 1 & B & B Bl 1 have had their lines
 run with fences & valuable improvements, the sur-
 counter 20354
