Dear Sir:-

I submit herewith a plat of some work I did in Dallam County, in March and April of this year, the relocation of the Joel Moore League at its location as established by E.F. Batte in 1902. At that time there were many of the original corners on the ground which he found and identified, whereas at this time all such corners have been obliterated by the plow, wind erosion, road building.

Beginning at a point in the East line of Dallam County, 1829.2 varas north of the S.E. corner of said county as established by Doucette and Spiller, and in the north line of survey 25, Block Q, which is five miles north of the north line of Block 44, H. & T.C.R.R.

Thence N. 89° 47' 30" W. parallel to the said north line of said block 44, eight miles plus 1431 varas (according to tie made by Doucette and Spiller) to the N.W. corner of the J.A. Moncrief Survey, an iron pipe.

Thence due North 1289.5 varas set a concret monument in the north line of Survey 21, Block 48, H. & T.C.R.R. 231 varas west of its N.E. corner, (found an iron pipe N. 89° 54' 47" W. 1669 varas) for the S.E. corner of the M.A. Willis tract, which checks Batte's position of this corner. I then checked and verified the corners of surveys 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, & 22, all in Block 48, H. & T.C.R.R.

Next I went to an iron pipe in road the original S.W. corner of survey 257, Block 1-T, T. & N.O.R.R. which I had previously checked with the original N.W. corner of survey 18, said Block 1-T, and checked with several iron pipe set by H.T. Trigg in said block 1-T, particularly the corners of 460, and established the west line of Block 1-A, C.T.R.R. From a three inch pipe set at corner of a fence in the west line of survey 10, said Block 1-A, for the N.E. corner of section 9, W.M. Pardue Sub-division, I retraced the surveys in this subdivision and established the N.E. corner of the Joel Moore League at the S.S.E. corner of survey 3, in the west line of survey 9, J.C. Patton Survey, which is the same position as given by Batte.

The west line of Block 1, Brooks and Burleson was established by A.S. Howren in 1903, and by him and H.T. Trigg in 1906, so from that line I established the N.E. corner of section 20, Block 1, B.S. & F. and the east line of said Block and at three and four miles respectively I found iron pipe which checked for the two east corners of section 25, said Block 1. B/S. & F.

Dear Sir:-

I submit herewith a plat of some work I did in Dallas County, in March and April of this year, the relocation of the Joel Moore League at its location as established by R.F. Bette in 1902. At that time there were many of the original corners on the ground which he found and identified, whereas at this time all such corners have been obliterated by the plow, wind erosion, road building.

Beginning at a point in the east line of Dallas County, 1822 S. varies north of the S.E. corner of said county as established by Donette and Spiller, and in the north line of survey 28, Block 6, which is five miles north of the north line of Block 44, E.A.T.C.R.R. Thence N. 89° 47' 30" W. parallel to the said north line of said block 44, eight miles plus 1821 varies (according to the made by Donette and Spiller) to the N.W. corner of the J.A. Moncrief Survey, an iron pipe. Thence due North 1822 S. varies set a concrete monument in the north line of Survey 21, Block 48, E.A.T.C.R.R. 231 varies west of the N.E. corner, (found an iron pipe N. 89° 54' 47" W. 1822 varies) for the S.E. corner of the M.A. Willis tract, which checks Bette's position of this corner. I then checked and verified the corners of surveys 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, & 22, all in Block 48, E.A.T.C.R.R. Next I went to an iron pipe in road the original S.W. corner of survey 20, Block 1-E, E.A.T.C.R.R. which I had previously checked with the original N.W. corner of survey 18, said Block 1-E, and checked with several iron pipes set by R.F. Bette in said block 1-E, particularly the corners of 400, and established the west line of Block 1-A, E.A.T.C.R.R. From a three inch pipe set at corner of a fence in the west line of survey 10, said Block 1-A, for the N.E. corner of section 7, W.M. Parbus Sub-division, I retraced the surveys in this subdivision and established the N.E. corner of the Joel Moore League at the S.E. corner of survey 7, in the west line of survey 7, J.C. Patton Survey, which is the same position as given by Bette. The west line of Block 1, Brooks and Basson was established by A.S. Howren in 1902, and by him and R.F. Bette in 1906, so from that line I established the N.E. corner of section 20, Block 1, E.A.T.C.R.R. and the east line of said Block and at three and four miles respectively I found iron pipe which checked for the two east corners of section 22, said Block 1, E.A.T.C.R.R.
