
Dear Sir:

In January 1917 Mr. C. B. Collard, then County Surveyor of Dawson County, made resurvey of Block 34, Township 4-North, T & P Ry. Surveys, in which resurvey, Mr. Murray Harris, at that time our engineer, cooperated. This resurvey was made for the purpose of clearing up certain conflicts which existed at that time, and it is our understanding that all parties interested agreed to the results of the resurvey.

Mr. Collard's field notes and plat were recorded at the time in Dawson County, but it seems that they were not recorded in your office. We now own no lands in Block 34, Township 4-North, Dawson County, but in the interest of present owners, we believe that the field notes and sketch of resurvey should be of record in your office.

Accordingly, we are forwarding you herewith certified copies of the field notes of each of the sections 1 to 48 inclusive, Block 34, Township 4-North, T & P Ry surveys, Dawson County, and also a certified copy of the plat made by Mr. Collard in 1917, with request that you file and record same in your office.
