Dear Sir:-

This office is in receipt of your letter of 10th. ult., enclosing a plat showing excess in Block K-4, Deaf Smith County, and note what you say concerning a proposed re-survey and adjustment of such excess in said block, and that you desire this office to indicate or

instruct you how same should be done.

The records of this office show that Block K-3 on the South and Block K-7 on the West have both been resurveyed and corrected field notes for same filed in this office. This work appears to have been made to conform to a survey covering Blocks K-3, K-4, K-7 and K-8 and adjoining territory, by W.D. Twichell in 1888, which was approved by W.S. Mabry, Surveyor of Oldham Land District. From an inspection of the original field notes of surveys in Block K-4 I do not find any marked or established corners called for that would give this block excess, but, inasmuch as it appears that the settlers have gone on the ground and built their improvements according to said Twichell survey, a re-survey of said block should respect the exterior corners and block lines as fixed by Twichell in 1888, from which the interior surveys should be constructed, distributing the excess, if any, thoughout the block on the same plan adopted in the recent resurvey of said Blocks K-3 and K-7.

This matter has been heretofore thoroughly discussed with your predecessors, Harvey G. Hays and R.O. Whyman, and the data and information furnished them should be on file in the surveyor's office.

Herewith find plat returned.
